WHAT IS YLEA?

The Youth Leadership Excellence Award (YLEA) presented by the Philippine Jaycees, Inc. in cooperation with the Department of Education and the office of Senator Francis “Kiko” N. Pangilinan as the main sponsor thru the DSWD to deserving graduating elementary and secondary school students from both public and private schools throughout the Philippines.

OBJECTIVE

Its objective is to give due recognition to outstanding (usually, but not necessarily, the Valedictorian) public and private elementary and secondary school students for their leadership qualities and academic achievement and to motivate them towards greater accomplishments in life.

RULES AND MECHANICS

1. The award is open to all graduating elementary (grade 6) and senior high school (grade 12) and moving-up junior high school (grade 10) students from both public and private schools situated in the Province of Capiz and recognized by the Department of Education – Capiz or Roxas City Division.
2. There shall be two (2) categories: ELEMENTARY and SECONDARY..
3. Each school may send a maximum of two (2) entries per category.
