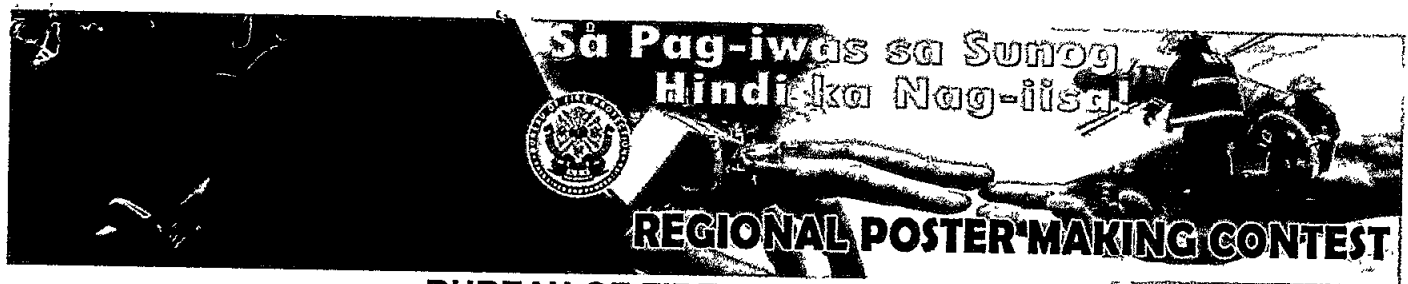

BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION 6 POSTER MAKING CONTEST

I. ABOUT

PINTA: The National Arts Contest Pinta (to draw) is the reinvented national arts contest with drawing and poster making events. Consciousness through art is a widely accepted methodology in promoting any form of advocacy. Through art, especially painting, participants to the event express their own understanding of a certain theme in a very expressive masterpiece that people admire. By injecting fire safety as a theme to arts contest open up a certain level of awareness to both the artist and audience.

II. MECHANICS

1. General Guidelines

- 1.1 The poster making contest is open to junior and senior high school students nationwide.
- 1.2 Entry pieces must illustrate an artistic interpretation of the general theme "Sa Pag-iwas sa Sunog, Hindi ka Nag-iisa"
- 1.3 Must be drawn/illustrated in a ½ size (20X30 inches) illustration board (Portrait Lay-out)- (sizes shall be strictly observed, otherwise entry will be disqualified) using crayon or oil-pastel.
- 1.4 Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title with brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry.
- 1.5 All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID.
- 1.6 No identifying marks shall be allowed in all entries.
- 1.7 All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size of exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said drawing/illustration.
- 1.8 The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.
- 1.9 Only materials provided by the BFP facilitator shall be used during the contest.

2. Administration of Contest

- 2.1 The contest will be on March 5, 2021, 8 o'clock in the morning and will be held at the Office of the Provincial Fire Marshal of each province and will be facilitated by the Fire Safety Enforcement Section representative in coordination with the Department of Education Provincial/District Offices on their selected contestant.
- 2.2 On the day of the contest, the contestants will be viewed live via ZOOM Cloud Application with the given link by the Regional Office as the host of the contest and shall be facilitated by the Office of the Provincial Fire Marshal as the co-host of the event.
- 2.3 After the allotted contest period of three (3) hours, outputs of the contest will be submitted to the facilitator.
- 2.4 During the regional evaluation in case of a tie, the chief judge decision will prevail.
- 2.5 Winners will be announced on the culminating program of the Fire Prevention Month on March 31, 2021 via ZOOM Cloud Application.
- 2.6 Prizes and awards will be received by the Provincial Fire Marshal of the winning contestant.

3. Criteria for Judging. The following criteria for each category shall be observed:

- **Theme relevance**
Does the poster effectively communicate the CY 2021 Fire Prevention Month Theme? -40%
 - **Creativity and Originality**
Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality? -30%
 - **Aesthetic Appeal**
Does the poster design captivate the judge's sense? Taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, Pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion? -30%

ESSAY WRITING CONTEST 2021**

MECHANICS

1. General Guidelines

- 1.1 The essay writing contest is open to junior high school students (Grade 7-10) regionwide.
- 1.2 Must be handwritten in a yellow pad paper using black ball pen to be provided by the BFP.
- 1.3 Composition must not exceed 750 words and must be written in English.
- 1.4 All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan – **"Sa Pag-iwas sa Sunog, Hindi ka Nag-iisa"**
- 1.5 Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title of the essay which shall be attached at the back of their entry.
- 1.6 All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID.
- 1.7 The BFP has the right to publish the winning entry on its official gazette; and
- 1.8 The decision of the Board of Judges is final and not appealable.
- 1.9 Only materials provided by the BFP facilitator shall be used during the contest.

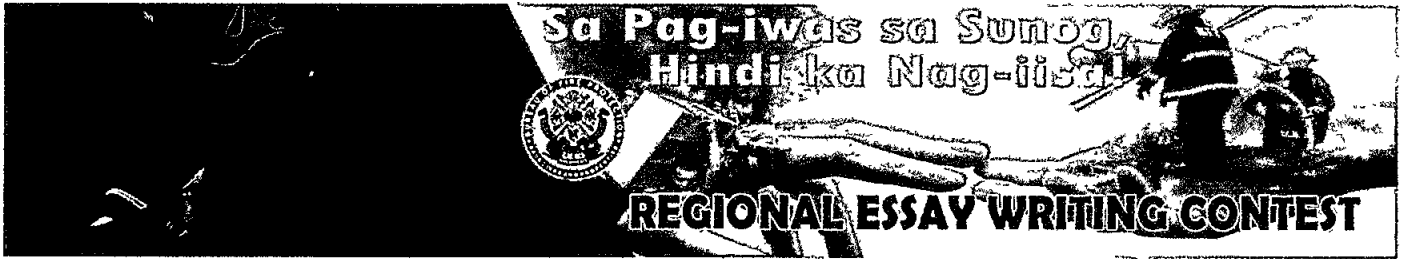
2. Administration of Contest

- 2.3 After the allotted contest period of three (3) hours, outputs of the contest will be submitted to the facilitator.
- 2.4 During the regional evaluation in case of a tie, the chief judge decision will prevail.
- 2.5 Winners will be announced on the culminating program of the Fire Prevention Month on March 31, 2021 via ZOOM Cloud Application.
- 2.6 Prizes and awards will be received by the Provincial Fire Marshal of the winning contestant.

3. Criteria for Judging

- **Theme relevance**
 - Does it demonstrate a clear understanding of the theme? -40%
 - Does it clearly relate to the topic?
 - Is it accurate and logical?
- **Presentation and Persuasion**
 - Is the grammar, spelling and punctuations correct? -30%
 - Is the article neatly written and has well-constructed paragraphs?
- **Creativity and Persuasion**
 - Are the ideas presented original?
 - Are there innovative ways of thinking? -30%
 - Does the writer dream outside the box?
 - Is there evidence of convincing and coherent line of argument?
 - Does the essay inspire the reader and move them to action?

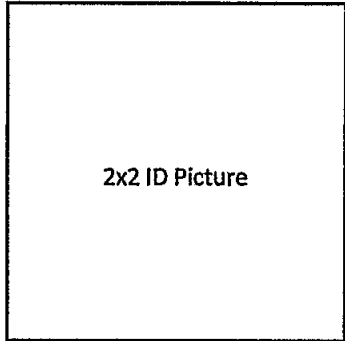

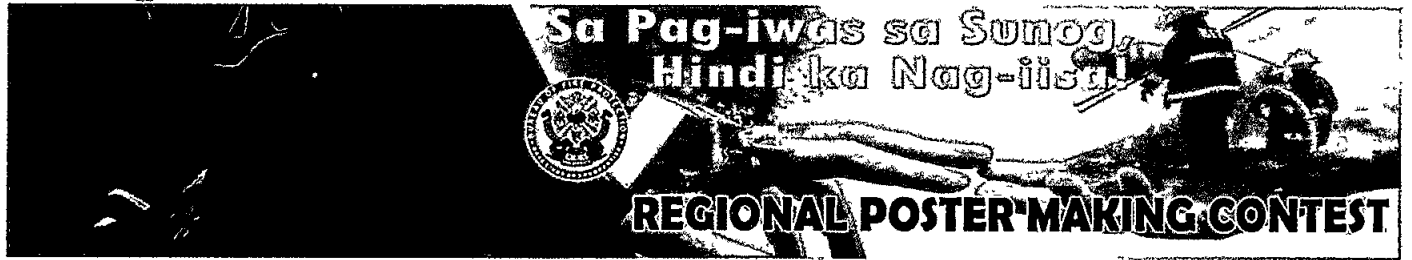

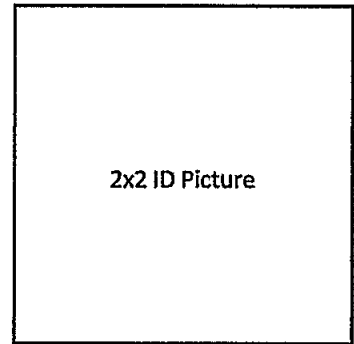
