Public Service greetings!

Do you know that studies have shown that personal financial issues greatly impact the work performance of an employee? Moreover, these financial problems result in an increase in stress among employees, workers' inability to focus at work, and absenteeism and tardiness.¹ In another survey, results show that adults were able to correctly answer only three (3) out of seven (7) financial literacy questions. The majority of Filipinos do not understand compounding interest rates, risk-return and investment diversification, the impact of inflation on the purchasing power of households, and comparing bargains. Evidently, even if financial concepts are taught in schools, they are not properly understood within the context of managing money and using financial services. The average Filipino, including government workers, thus face a greater risk of making decisions that compromise their financial health – such as delaying saving, mismanaging credit, bypassing legitimate investment opportunities, or worse, falling into investment scams.²

Considering the above-mentioned premises, the Civil Service Commission sees financial education as crucial in building the financial skills of government workers. For its part, the Civil Service Commission Regional Office VI is offering a webinar to government workers that will equip them with the knowledge, skills, and strategies that will aid them in making sound financial decisions that will address their current needs as well as prepare them for their future, which will ultimately redound to their better performance and efficiency

The webinar, **PERALyzed: A Financial and Lifestyle Management Webinar for Government Employees**, will be held on October 28, 2022, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Among the topics to be
