ABOUT MAOSOC

The Batang Capiznon Awards: The Municipal Award for Outstanding Students of Capiz is an award program for outstanding students in the different Municipalities in the Province of Capiz. It is an initiative of the Borres Youth Leadership Institute, Inc. that aims to localize the Batang Capiznon Awards: Search for the Ten Outstanding Students of Capiz (TOSOC) with modified rules and mechanics considering that the entry to the TOSOC award is limited only to twenty (20) finalists in the entire Province of Capiz.

OBJECTIVES

The award aims to:

1. **expand** the award program for outstanding students in the different Municipalities in the Province of Capiz;
2. **recognize** the exemplary performance of the students in their studies, contribution to student leadership and deep sense of social responsibility;
3. **equip** students with necessary skills, attitudes, values and national identity through holistic leadership formation;
4. **provide** an venue to empower and prepare the students to take active leadership roles in nation-building; and
5. **create** a community of outstanding volunteer leaders in the different Municipalities in the Province of Capiz.

RULES AND MECHANICS

I. Who can be recipients of the award?

1. The recipient of the award must be a graduating elementary pupil (Grade 6 level) and senior high school student (Grade 12 level) of a public and private elementary, secondary and integrated schools situated in the Municipalities in the Province of Capiz **and** nominated or endorsed by their respective schools through their adviser/coach and school head.
2. There shall be two (2) categories: **ELEMENTARY** and **SECONDARY CATEGORIES**.

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3. Each school shall send their respective nominees according to the following:

II. Qualification

NO.	QUALIFICATION
1	A Filipino citizen;
2	A <i>bona fide</i> graduating Grade 6 pupil or Grade 12 senior high school student for academic year 2022-2023;
3	Nominated or endorsed by the school through his/her adviser/coach and school head;
4	Resident of the Municipality in the Province of Capiz;
5	Has not been subjected to any disciplinary action or obtained derogatory record;
6	Has an outstanding academic record and must not have obtained any DROPPED or FAILING GRADE. Any INC grade must have a completion grade;
7	Must have a significant achievement in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities (non-academic awards, attendance in seminars/trainings & positions held in organizations) and involvement in community service activities;
8	Must be willing and committed to become a BYLI volunteer/member;
9	Must be willing to participate and commit to the post-MAOSOC and other BYLI activities;
10	Must have accepted the nomination or endorsement made by the school.

NOTE: TOSOC Finalists shall automatically be disqualified to be nominated by the school.

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III. Criteria in selecting the school's nominees

1. Curricular/Non-Academic Recognition/Awards
2. Seminars and Trainings Attended
3. Leadership Positions in Organizations

iii. COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMS, PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

1. Involvement in Community Outreach Activities

IV. Documentary requirements

1. Accomplished Nomination Form (see attached form) – to be filled out by the official adviser/coach and duly noted by the school head.
2. Acceptance Form (see attached form) – to be filled out by the official school nominee.

V. Procedure

1. Each public and private elementary, secondary and integrated school shall create its own school screening committee that will identify, screen and select the school's nominee. The committee shall be composed of the following:
 - i. School Head
 - ii. Senior High School Coordinator
 - iii. Coach/Teacher Adviser
2. Each public and private elementary, secondary and integrated school shall select their own nominees according to the qualifications and criteria mentioned-above;
3. The selected nominees must have an official teacher adviser or coach as determined by the school. They may only have one (1) coach/teacher adviser or each of them may have a separate coach/teacher adviser;
4. The chosen nominee by the school shall automatically become the awardee or recipient of the award.
5. The school shall accomplish the nomination form and the recipient shall accomplish the acceptance form.
6. The forms shall be submitted to the BYLI for compilation.

- i. Medal
- ii. Certificate of Recognition to the Awardee
- iii. Certificate of Recognition to the Teacher Adviser/Coach
- iv. Certificate of Recognition to the Participating Schools

VII. Privileges

- i. Be considered a BYLI volunteer

- iii. Opportunity to participate in all BYLI activities
