SUBJECT: 2023 INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEAN-UP

- 1. Presidential Proclamation No. 470 Series of 2003, declared the Third (3rd) Saturday of September of each year as the "International Coastal Clean-Up Day". This year's International Coastal Clean-Up will be celebrated on the third Saturday of this month September 16, 2023.
- 2. International Coastal Clean-up aims to engage people around the world to remove trash and debris from beaches, waterways and other water bodies, to identify the sources of the litter, to change behaviours that cause pollution and to raise awareness on the extent of the marine debris problem.
- 3. Taking into consideration the Environment Educational and Sustainability program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, all Scouts and Scout Leaders is encouraged to initiate the conduct of a clean-up drive activity that include cleaning and collecting the trashes that pollutes our water ways at homes, schools, communities, public plaza, parks, coastal areas, forest areas, watershed areas, campsites and other suitable areas.
- 4. Pictorials and narrative report, shall be submitted to the BSP, Capiz Council Office, as verified and confirmed by the respective District Scouting Commissioner/District Field Scout Commissioner/Institutional Scouting Representative on or before October 13, 2023.
- 5. Please wear your Scout neckerchief during the conduct of the activity.
- 6. Certificate of Recognition will be issued to all Scouts and Scouts Leaders who will be Participating and taking part of the said activity.
