GUIDELINE IN JOINING THE COMPETITION:

ELIGIBILITY

 Fo Guang Shan 3G Solo Singing Competition is open all G5-G12 students who are enrolled in the different TAG schools for SY 2023-2024 under Department of Education nationwide.

CATEGORY A – aged 11 – 14 years old CATEGORY B – aged 15 – 18 years old

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Registration is free.
- There will be two levels for the said competition.

-Semi Final Round - will be done via zoom. Each division will send 2 representatives for the semi-final round. One (1) semi-finalist for Category A and one (1) semi-finalist for Category B. The contestants will sing face to face, but the judges will be virtually watching them via zoom on September 30, 2023. Twenty (20) contestants (10 for each category) will be selected and will move on to the final round.

-Grand Finals – will be held in Fo Guang Shan Mabuhay Temple on October 21, 2023. 6 grand winners will be selected (3 from each category). The contestants and their teacher trainer or their parent will be coming to Manila on the said date. Fo Guang Shan Foundation Inc. will sponsor their ticket for the airfare or landfare while accommodation and food will be sponsored by BLIA.

Note: Student contestant and trainer/ coach must submit their vaccination card (with at least 1 booster shot) first before FGS buy their ticket round trip to Manila for the Grand Finals and must have a waiver.

- Interested students may join for the solo competition. Back-up dancers are allowed but not required. Students may come up with own rendition of the choice song provided by FGS.
- Dress code must be decent, no halter, thin strap, backless, revealing blouses nor shorts nor torn clothes revealing body parts clothes will be allowed.
- Student who will participate in the semi-final round must be at venue at least one (1) hour before the competition, late participants will automatically be disqualified.
- Each Student will be given maximum of 5 minutes stage time to perform. The song and lyrics must be memorized. (No video screen will be used)
- Student participants must request for written approval from FGS Philippines beforehand for the use of props for their performance.
- Fo Guang Shan Philippines shall only provide stage and microphone/s for each Student participant.
- Singers are not allowed to change the words of the lyrics.
- Student participants are strongly advised to exercise with extra care when singing and dancing on the stage, Fo Guang Shan Philippines will not be liable nor responsible to any loss, damage or injury sustained by any contestants during the course of competition.
- No Parents, Students, Teacher/s nor Mentor/s shall approach student participant/s at the waiting area.
- Fo Guang Shan Philippines has the full authority to disqualify any student participant should they find any irregularity or any act of indecency on or before/during the competition.
- Tokens & appreciations will be released to winners on the day of competition.
- Schools are required to submit Certificate of Appreciation address to Fo Guang Shan Foundation Inc. for the invitation to join the singing competition one week before the competition date.

QUALIFYING ROUNDS

The contest is open to all students under the different TAG Schools all over the Philippines. There will be two categories for the said competition. CATEGORY A will be from age 11-14 and CATEGORY B is from 15-18 years old. Male or female may join as long as they've got the talent in singing.

PRELIMINARY ROUND

 Each Division/ School may conduct their own elimination process or may opt to choose among the students from their TAG schools. Two (2) representatives will be sent by each Division to the semi-final round (1 for Category A and 1 for Category B).

SEMI - FINAL ROUND

Each division will send 2 representatives for the semi-final round. One (1) semi-finalist for Category A and one (1) semi-finalist for Category B. This will be held on September 30, 2023, at 9am. Zoom link will be provided prior to the said competition. 20 contestants (10 from each category) will be chosen for the final round.

FINAL ROUND

- The final 20 contestants together with their trainer or parent will come to Manila on or before October 21, 2023, for a face-to-face contest proper. Accommodation, transportation, and food will be sponsored by BLIA and Fo Guang Shan Foundation Inc.

DATES TO REMEMBER:

September 30, 2023 - Semi Final Round (20 will be chosen, 10/category)

October 21, 2023 - Grand Finals at FGS Manila (3 winners /category will be chosen)

October 20, 2023 - Expected arrival of the finalists at FGS Manila

October 22, 2023 - Expected return of finalists in their hometown.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Standard Judge Scoring sheet with same criteria will be used in each competition round.
- Judging for preliminary and semi-final round will be done virtually while during the grand final rounds will be done on a be a face-to-face basis following the criteria provided below:
- The criterion for judging is good for the two categories Category A (Age 11-14) and Category B (Age 15-18).
- 1. 30% Vocal Technique: Includes tone quality, breathing, intonation and diction.
- 2, 30% Musicality: Includes rhythm, timing, and dynamics
- 3. 20% Overall Performance Style: Accurately grasp the theme of the song ideas, line instrument performance, song content and style with a degree of sentiment and appeal.
- 4. 10% Choice of Material: Singer chose proper song that shows Three Acts of Goodness (Do Good Deeds, Speak Good Words, and Think Good Thoughts) to showcase their abilities.
- 5. 10% Stage Dominance Star Factor/Uniqueness, self-confidence, versatility.
