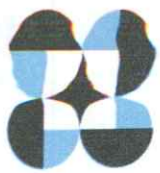

Dear **Dr. Aposin**:

The Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) is pleased to inform you of the availability of the **2024 Science and Technology Undergraduate Scholarship Programs**. DOST-SEI will award scholarships in baccalaureate degree programs to students with high aptitude in science and mathematics and willing to pursue priority fields of study in Basic Sciences, Engineering, and other Applied Sciences and Science Teaching courses. Graduating grade 12 students for SY 2023-2024 under the STEM strand are automatically qualified to apply, while applicants from the NON-STEM strand must belong to the top five percent (5%) of the senior high school graduating class.

There are two scholarship programs being offered. They are as follows:

1. **RA 7687 Science and Technology Scholarship Program** – Republic Act No. 7687, also known as the “Science and Technology Scholarship Act of 1994”, provides scholarships to talented and deserving students whose family socio-economic status does not exceed the set cut-off values of certain indicators (i.e gross annual income).
2. **SEI Merit Scholarship Program** – formerly known as NSDB or NSTA Scholarship under RA No. 2067, is awarded to students with high aptitude in science and mathematics.

The scholarship privileges are:

- a. Tuition and other school fees (for scholars enrolled in private Universities/Colleges) not to exceed Php 20,000.00/semester;
- b. Learning Materials and/or Connectivity Allowance - Php 10,000.00/academic year;
- c. Clothing Allowance of Php 1,000.00 for first semester, first year only;
- d. Transportation Allowance for one economy-class round trip fare between permanent residence and place of study on reimbursement basis (for those studying outside of their home province);
- e. Monthly living allowance of Php 7,000.00;
- f. Thesis allowance of Php 10,000.00.
- g. Group accident and health insurance;
- h. Additional privileges during summer if required in the curriculum; and
- i. Graduation Allowance at Php 1,000.00.

Please help us disseminate this opportunity in your jurisdiction as well as encourage students to pursue S&T courses to contribute to the development of their community. Applicants may now access the application and required documents thru <https://www.science-scholarships.ph> until December 31, 2023. Qualified applicants will take the examination scheduled on **April 6 and 7, 2024**.
