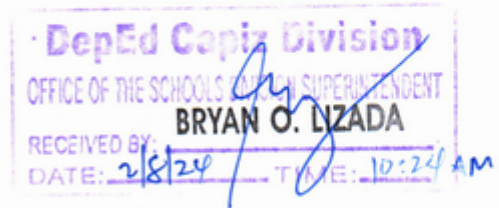

## WISE AWARDS YEAR 4 GUIDELINES

For this year, the Women Innovators of Society and Education (WISE) program seek to recognize outstanding women educators who have made their contribution and effort with their innovative programs and projects implemented in their respective institutions designed to address the impacts of pandemics and the challenges of going back to face-to-face classes.

### General Guidelines:

#### Eligibility:

1. Women school heads, assistant school heads, and women educators in the Division of Roxas City and Division of Capiz (1<sup>st</sup> District).
2. Must have accomplished an innovative program or project aimed at developing a more effective and efficient approach to create a more engaging and learning environment for students
3. Must have shown dedication, sacrifice, and commitment in achieving quality education with emphasis on a more child-friendly, gender-sensitive, safe, and motivating environment.

#### How to join:

1. Hopefuls are required to submit the following requirements in a **Long Purple Folder** on or before (March 3, 2023) at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Office of BM Thea Faith T. Reyes, Capiz Provincial Capitol:
  - a. Duly accomplished **Application form (Annex A)**.
  - b. A **complete bio-note** on the entrant of no more than 500 words, accompanied with a detailed **Personal Data Sheet**.
  - c. A **narrative report detailing the program or project**, its impacts, target beneficiaries, and sustainability components spearheaded by the entrant; not less than 1000 words, and not more than 3000 words; typewritten on A4 sized bond paper, double spaced.
  - d. A photo and/or video documentation of the program. Entrants may submit both or either one.
2. Hopefuls should be able to submit both Hard copy and Soft copy (PDF file) of the above mentioned documents.
3. All submissions will be reviewed by the WISE committee and twenty (20) finalists will be selected.
4. The twenty (20) finalists will be invited for a panel interview and socials on a date and venue to be later announced.
5. Out of the twenty (20) finalists, ten (10) will be named honorable mentions and ten (10) will be named this year's WISE awardee (1 awardee from the municipalities of Panay, Panit-an, Pontevedra, President Roxas, Maayon, Pilar and 4 awardees from Roxas City).

6. The criteria for review of the entry submissions is as follows:

a. Completeness of submission	10%
b. Project/program impact	40%
c. Sustainability	20%
d. Innovation	20%
e. Replicability	10%

7. The criteria for the panel interview will be as follows:

a. Knowledgeability and eloquence on the project/program	25%
b. Demonstrated commitment and dedication	20%
c. Vision for replication and sustainability	20%
d. Flexibility and proactivity with potential program/project changes	20%
e. Project Presentation	15%

8. The decision of the judges/reviewers is final and irrevocable.

9. Important dates:

a. Deadline for submission of portfolio	February 21, 2024 (Monday)
b. Announcement of 20 Finalists	March 4, 2024 (Monday)
c. Panel interview and judging of 20 finalists	March 9, 2024 (Saturday)
d. Awarding ceremonies	March 22, 2024 (Saturday)
