He has been awarded the Regional Prize for Visayas of the Philippine Art Awards in 2007. He was also the Vice Chairman of the Committee in Visual Arts of the National Commission for Culture of the Arts in 2017-2019.

He is a retired Associate Professor in the Fine Arts Program of UP Cebu where he has been teaching for 32 years. His works are often depictions of local myths with social and political connotations, done in mixed media.
