

The project's main goal is to recognize outstanding public and private elementary and high school graduating students, highlighting their academic achievements and leadership qualities.

In line with this, we humbly seek your support in disseminating this letter to interested schools and young leaders. The following guidelines must be observed for a student to be considered as a **YLEA nominee**:

Eligibility Criteria:

- Awardees must be graduating elementary, junior high school, or senior high school students with notable academic achievements and leadership involvement (e.g., student councils, school clubs, scouts, varsity teams, or other organizations).
- Prior academic and leadership experiences may also be considered.

Awardee Limitation:

- Each school may select up to two (2) awardees for the elementary level and two (2) for the junior high school or senior high school level.
- Recommendations must be endorsed by the school principal or administrator.

Selection:

 The school principal/administrator shall form a selection committee in their respective schools to select their awardee/s (see Google Drive for document sample). Likewise, the school principal/administrator shall issue a letter of recommendation for their official nominees.

• The evaluation form must be signed by the Selection Committee established by the school (*see Google Drive for document sample*). Once issued, the decision of the partner schools as to the YLEA nominees/ awardees shall be final and unappealable.
