The National Association of Public Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NAPSSPHIL), Incorporated, in partnership with the Department of Agriculture and Gawad Kalinga Community Development Foundation, Incorporated, co-organized by leading Filipino agri-institutions Sante Feeds Corporation and La Filipina Uy Gongco will hold a **LIVE-IN BayanAnihan Summit** on May 28 – 30, 2025 at Kansilayan Gym, Silay City, Negros Occidental.

The BayanAnihan Summit is a series of three-day event that will uplift and celebrate fishers, foresters, and farmers. This event will gather students, teachers (Farm School, TLE- Agriculture) school heads, and other personnel in agriculture in the Philippines. This initiative aims to harness the expertise of Farm School teachers, TLE-Agriculture teachers, school heads, and other personnel in agriculture, connecting them to opportunities or enhanced productivity. The summit will provide a comprehensive platform for these teachers to connect with government, private sector, and civil society stakeholders. The key output of the summit is the BayanAnihan Youth Movement, where participants will lead agri-initiatives in their own communities, fostering a culture of innovation and sustainable agriculture within educational institutions.

The participation of public school personnel shall be subject to the non-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No.9, s.2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and ensuring compliance therewith,

A registration fee of seven thousand five hundred pesos (7,500 Php) shall be charged to each participant to cover expenses for hotel accommodation, meals and snacks, venue rental, honoraria for resource persons and facilitators, and other incidental expenses, chargeable against school MOOE and/or other local funds, subject to COA accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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## **EVENT PRIMER**

### **OVERVIEW**

The **BayanAnihan Summit – Public School Edition** is a nationwide gathering that brings together public elementary and secondary school principals, TLE-agriculture students, and key partners in education and development to uplift and celebrate the next generation of Filipino agri-leaders. 'BayanAnihan' merges the root words 'bayan' (country), 'bayani' (hero), 'ani' (harvest), and 'bayanihan' (solidarity with others).

Launched in August 2024, the **BayanAnihan Movement** began as a youth-led initiative that brought together young farmers, fishers, and foresters across the islands. Now in 2025, the movement is growing through our public schools—where the future of food security begins in the classroom and takes root in the community.

Rooted in the word bayan or country, the BayanAnihan Summit – Public Secondary School Edition brings the movement into the heart of our school communities. While previous summits spanned Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao, this edition focuses on empowering students and educators in public secondary schools—where the seeds of national transformation can be planted early. The summit honors young people in agriculture as modern-day bayani—heroes who will shape a food-secure and sustainable future. It highlights ani, the harvest, as a symbol both of the productivity and the potential of every student to contribute to national progress. At its core, the summit embraces bayanihan—the Filipino spirit of coming together—by creating a shared space for collaboration between schools, government, private institutions, and communities, all working side by side to support and grow the future changemakers in agriculture.

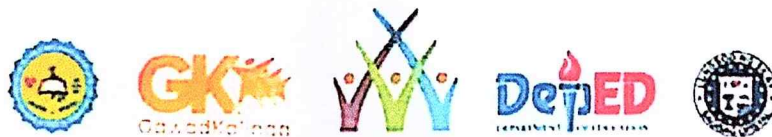
### **OBJECTIVES**

1. **Convergence:** Create a space for public school students and educators to connect with peers, local leaders, and national partners in agriculture, fisheries, and forestry.
2. **Knowledge:** Facilitate knowledge transfer through highlighting significant topics, issues, and strategies in each agricultural sector
3. **Opportunities:** Facilitate concrete opportunities for young agri-leaders to access opportunities in investment, training, business and employment.
4. **Action:** Inspire participants to lead their own BayanAnihan initiatives within their schools and communities—applying what they've learned to local projects and youth-driven efforts.

### **ACTIVITIES**

1. **Conference:** Activities that highlight significant topics, issues, and best practices, including panel discussions with industry and academe experts, and keynote speeches from advocates and thought leaders
2. **Connection:** Activities that provide opportunities for students and teachers to meet, exchange ideas, and build partnerships through networking spaces, trade fairs, and MOA signings with schools, agencies, and agri-groups.
3. **Competition:** Activities that celebrate talent and creativity of students such as quiz bees, fruit carving, slogan and poster making, and the BayanAnihan Race, all rooted in agri-based themes and values.

4. **Countryside Fair:** Showcase and sale of local food products, ready-to-eat meals, agri-supplies, handmade goods, and school-made merchandise.
5. **Celebrations:** Lively cultural performances, social activities, raffles, and games that bring the community together and celebrate the spirit of bayanihan.
