Guidelines

- Must be a bona fide member of an accredited or recognized school Red Cross Youth Council.
- Must have a valid Membership with accident assurance benefits (MAAB)
 ID.
- Must have attended the Youth Volunteer Formation Course.
- Must be physically and mentally fit.
- Must declare any health-related problems they are experiencing during the camp. A health declaration form will be filled out before the commencement of the daily activities.
- Must secure the following:
 Duly accomplished Registration Form
 Duly signed Child Protection Policy Code
- Strictly NO REFUND once payment has been made.
- Registration Fee is NEITHER TRANSFERABLE NOR CONVERTIBLE.
- ONSITE REGISTRATION will not be accepted
- Each participating council will be responsible for travel expenses to and from the venue.
- Tents will be used for accommodation, and each council will be assigned a designated area. It is the prerogative of each participating council to decide what type of tent they will be using. Room assignments will only be given if necessary and upon the committee's discretion.
- The councils must be responsible for their food. Catering will not be allowed.
- Each council must provide its respective first aid kit, a school and/or RCY council banner, a garbage bag, and a container for water storage.
- Each participant must bring their camping paraphernalia (pump out tent, pillows, nets, blanket, etc.), personal/hygiene kit and utensils, clothes good for the entire duration of the camp, flashlight, extra batteries/power bank and personal water container for drinking.
- Participants must keep their valuables. The committee will not be responsible for any loss.
- Participants are expected to wear comfortable casual clothes during the duration of the camp. (Round neck/polo shirt, maong/jogging pants, closed shoes: rubber/tennis shoes.) Slippers, shorts, and sandos/sleeveless are strictly not allowed during sessions and activities.
