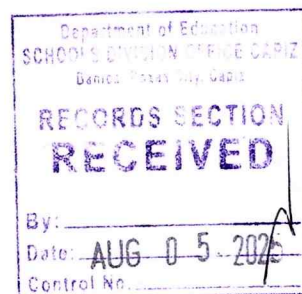

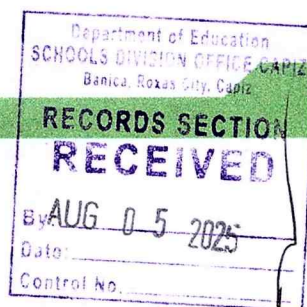

**TO : REGIONAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICERS
COUNCIL SCOUT EXECUTIVES AND OFFICERS-IN-CHARGE**

SUBJECT : CLARIFICATIONS ON REQUIREMENTS FOR SCOUT REGISTRATION

1. Following the ratification of the amendments to the National By-Laws of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) during the 67th Annual National Council Meeting held last May 15-17, 2024 in Zamboanga City, the definition of Scouts under Section 2 of Article XII now reads as follows:

"Section 2. Scouts. Scouts are young people carrying out the Scouting Program in its various Sections as defined in the handbooks and Scout manuals."

2. This amendment is consistent with the policy of the State to pursue equal opportunities for women and men, ensure equal access to resources and to development results and outcomes (Republic Act No. 9710). Likewise, this amendment is consistent with the nature of the Scout Movement, as enshrined in the Constitution of the World Organization of the Scout Movement, that it is open to all young people without distinction of gender, origin, race or creed.
3. Highlighting the voluntary nature of the membership to the Scout Movement as well as the Constitutional right to association and expression, it is clarified that registration as a Scout shall not require any other pre-requisite other than those already mentioned in the Membership Requirements for each of the Scouting sections of the BSP. This includes the payment of an annual registration fee solely and directly to the BSP through its duly chartered Local Councils, among others.
4. Continuous compliance to sex-disaggregated reporting and to existing Safe from Harm guidelines particularly in youth program implementation is hereby reiterated.
5. All previous issuances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked and/or modified accordingly.
