

#### 2. This training course aims to:

- a. To train the Unit Leaders in their responsibilities and to equip them with necessary scouting skills and techniques as Scout Leaders in scouting;
- b. Demonstrate the skills involved in program activities through the use of prescribed methods and techniques in Scouting with emphasis on outdoor life;
- c. Display further enthusiasm and commitment to the aims and purpose of Scouting;
- d. Identify and avail the opportunities for self-improvement.

#### 3. Qualifications:

- a. Must be a registered Scout Leader of the BSP
- b. Should be physically, mentally, and medically fit (medical certificate is required)
- 4. A Registration Fee of Two Thousand Two Hundred Pesos Only (P2,200.00) shall be charged to each participant to defray the cost of meals and snacks, training supplies/materials, Adult Necker, carabao slide and other related administrative and program expenses. Registration fee, transportation, incidental and other miscellaneous expenses related hereto are chargeable against local funds or MOOE, subject to its availability and the prescribed accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Things to Bring

Preferably type A or Type B uniform (white T-Shirt), long pants, rubber shoes, Personal Medicines, toiletries, insect repellent, sleeping gear, dome tent, etc.

6. Scout Leaders will participate in this scouting event will be granted service credit for services rendered on Saturday and Sunday, subject to existing rules and guidelines as DepEd Order No. 13, 2024.
