

SUBJECT: 33rd Asia Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree – PRE JAMBOREE TRAINING

1. The Pre-Jamboree Training will be conducted on December 8, 2025, at Capiz National High School, Tiza, Roxas City, in preparation for the upcoming 33rd Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree to be held from December 12-22, 2025, in Botolan, Zambales, with the theme "**Be Prepared: Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development**".
2. The Pre-Jamboree training aims to prepare all participating Scouts and Scout leaders for their active participation in the **33rd Asia Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree**. It serves as an orientation and skills enhancement activity designed to:

Skill Development: Participants engage in Scoutcraft activities, such as knot tying, pioneering, first aid, tracking, and camp cooking, to ensure proficiency in basic Scouting skills.

Physical and Mental Preparedness: The training includes strenuous outdoor activities to build physical fitness and resilience. It also helps participants prepare mentally for the demands of a large international encampment, including heat and humidity.

Logistics and Safety Orientation: Scouts and leaders learn about the safety protocols, the buddy system, personal hygiene, and emergency procedures for the main Jamboree. This includes how to pack correctly and manage their equipment.

Unit and Crew Bonding: Activities are designed to build teamwork and camaraderie within the contingent's Crews and units, essential for a harmonious and successful experience at the main event.

Program Introduction: Participants are introduced to the core program areas of the main Jamboree, which include activities aligned with the theme "Be Prepared: Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development" and World Scouting thrusts like Environment Education and Peace Education.

Administrative Requirements: The training ensures all administrative requirements are met, such as having the correct documentation, proper uniform, and necessary camping gear.

3. Things to Bring:

- a. Type A/B Uniform
- b. Tent with fly
- c. Backpack with clothing
- d. Parents' Consent

4. Registration: No Registration fee will be collected during the Pre-Jamboree Training. However, participating Scouts and Scout Leaders are required to bring lunch and snacks for the entire duration of the activity.

5. Pre-Jamboree Call Time: All participants are required to report at 8:00 AM- 4:00 PM.

6. Scout Leaders will participate in this scouting event will be granted service credit for services rendered on Saturday, Sunday and Holiday, subject to existing rules and guidelines as per Decs Memorandum 143 series of 1997 and (enclosed to DO No. 13, 2024- Section V A.1.b, 8. c.) DepEd Order No. 13, 2024.
