
**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

**10<sup>th</sup> CAPIZ DIVISION VALUES EDUCATION SUMMIT CUM SEMINAR  
ON 101 WAYS TO TEACH EsP**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/Officers-In-charge of the District  
Heads of Public Secondary and Integrated Schools

1. The Division of Capiz will hold its 10<sup>th</sup> **Capiz Division Values Education Summit cum Seminar on 101 Ways to Teach EsP** at Robinsons Place- Roxas, Roxas City on November 3-5, 2017 with the theme: **"PSEP at DepEd: Magkabalikat sa Pagtataguyod ng EsP sa Kto12 BEC"**.
2. The summit aims to:
  - a. provide the participants with deeper understanding of their role in strengthening the EsP curriculum in the Kto12 BEC;
  - b. develop skills and strategies in teaching EsP; and
  - c. enhance students' creative participation and character performance in the promotion and strengthening of Filipino virtues and values through arts and intellectual challenge.
3. Participants to this three-day activity are the following:
  - a. November 3, 2017 (1<sup>st</sup> day) – one EsP district coordinator and one EsP school coordinator per district and one EsP coordinator per secondary school
  - b. November 4, 2017 (2<sup>nd</sup> day) – contestants, trainers, coaches and district EsP coordinators in the elementary level contests
  - c. November 5, 2017 (3<sup>rd</sup> day) – contestants, trainers, coaches, school KPSEP presidents and EsP coordinators in the secondary level contests
4. Highlighting the summit are the following: Lectures on 101 Ways to Teach EsP, Tagis-Talino in EsP, On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest and Sayawit for elementary and secondary and Division K-PSEP Election of Officers. Attached is the summit matrix and contest mechanics for your perusal.
5. A registration fee of One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00) shall be charged to each participant in EsP Competitions to cover expenses for food and travel allowance of guests and judges, summit supplies and materials and other related expenses relative to the conduct of the activity while expenses during the lecture on 101 Ways to Teach EsP for teachers shall be charged to the Division Inset Fund.
6. Registration, food and travel expenses of the student participants and teachers relative to their participation to this activity shall be charged against Local Funds/School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

### Rules of the Contest-TAGIS TALINO

1. The teams will compete in the Easy (1 pt), Average (3pts.), and Difficult (5pts.) categories.
2. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the contents of EsP 7-10 (EsP Modyul para sa Mag-aaral) for secondary and and EsP 1-6 (EsP Modyul para sa Mag-aaral) for elementary.
3. Questions will come from participating school (secondary) and district (elementary). EsP Coordinators are requested to submit three (3) questions for every category including in the clincher round. Questions must be encoded in a one fourth size long coupon bond, landscape, 12 size Tahoma font. Submission of questions will be two (2) weeks before the contest date. Submit the questions to Mr. Alan Vincent B. Altamia, EPS in-charge of EsP or to Mrs. Mary Grace C. Daradar at the CID, SDO, Banica, Roxas City. **LATE SUBMISSION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
4. The quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team will be given 15 seconds to write the answer on the prescribed answer sheet then wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answers. The proctor will check the answer and the scorers will tally the scores on the scoreboard.
5. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask another question. The team who got the first correct answer will be automatically declared as winner.
6. Teams are advised to bring their own long bond paper, pentel pen.

### Rules of the Contest- SAYAWIT

1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the activity theme.
2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes.
3. Number of participants performing the singing and dancing at the same time should be 7-10. Technical assistants must be students/pupils from same school/district but not considered performers. However, they should be registered.
4. Contestants may use props and other stage sets.
5. Live accompaniment is required. No lip-synchs.
6. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements.

1. Concept and Relevance to the theme	-	40%
2. Choreography	-	20%
3. Musicality	-	20%
4. Props, Costumes and Audio-Visual effects	-	20%

### Rules of the Contest- ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING

1. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials
  - a. 1/2 illustration board
  - b. pencil
  - c. pastel/craypass
2. Pentel pen and signing pen are not allowed.
3. Contestants are given 3 hours time allotment.
4. No slogan/writings in the poster.
