**2017 DIVISION PRESS CONFERENCE FOR FILIPINO AND ENGLISH
(SECONDARY LEVEL)**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors
Public and Private Secondary and Integrated School Administrators
All Others Concerned

1. The Division of Capiz will conduct a One Day Press Conference for Filipino and English Secondary Level on September 30, 2017 at Capiz National High School, Roxas City.
2. This activity aims to :
 - a. determine the best campus journalism writers from among the secondary school to represent the Division of Capiz in the Regional Press Conference; and
 - b. tap the best school paper advisers in the secondary level and provide them more technical assistance and enhance their coaching strategies for the Regional Press Conference (RPC).
3. The Press Conference Management will charge PhP 70.00 registration and PhP 30.00 membership fee for every participant including the advisers/coaches to cover contest materials, certificates for the participants, medals and trophies for the winners, subsistence for the judges and facilitators, administrative costs, and other incidental expenses that maybe incurred in the conduct of the said activity.
4. There are eight (8) individual categories to be joined in namely: **News, Sports, Editorial, Feature, Editorial Cartooning, Headline and Copy Reading, Science Writing.**
5. Participants in the Radio Broadcasting and Scriptwriting contests should not be entries in the Individual Writing category. Each school shall have one (1) team composed of seven (7) members to broadcast in either English or Filipino or both. Contestants should bring their laptops and printers and extensions.
6. Photo journalism contestants should bring their own digital camera with mega pixel 12-16 and laptop.
7. There will b one (1) entry for each category per school. Participants are advised to bring packed lunch and snacks.
8. Pre-registration will be on September 26, 2017 at 1:30 PM during the English and Filipino Coordinators' meeting at the Division Multi-Purpose Hall.
9. Membership fee is chargeable against the school paper fund while registration, travel and other allowable expenses relative to participation to this activity are chargeable against the school paper, MOOE and other sources of fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
