**TWO-DAY SKILLS ENHANCEMENT WORKSHOP ON JOURNALISM BOTH IN ENGLISH  
AND FILIPINO  
( ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY LEVEL)**

1. The Division of Capiz will conduct a two-day skills enhancement workshop on Journalism both in English and Filipino (Elementary and Secondary) at Comsr. Luis R. Asis NHS, Panay Capiz on November 10-11, 2017 to start at eight o'clock in the morning.

**November 10, 2017-** News Writing, Editorial Writing , Copy Reading and Headline Writing, Collaborative Writing, and Feature Writing Contestants and Coaches

**November 11, 2017-** Sports Writing, Science and Technology Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Photojournalism and Collaborative writing contestants and coaches

1. This activity aims to:
  - a. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for the participants to the Regional Schools Press Conference ;
  - b. enhance journalistic competence of pupils/students; and
  - c. provide coaches more technical help and coaching strategies for the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC).
2. The participants to this activity are the top 10 Winners of the individual contests with their respective coaches during the 2017 Division Schools Press Conference.
3. The participants on News Writing, Editorial Writing , Copy Reading and Headline Writing, Collaborative Writing, and Feature Writing Contestants and Coaches should report only on November 10, 2017, while participants on Sports Writing, Science and Technology Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Photojournalism and Collaborative Writing should report on November 11, 2017.
4. Expenses incurred relative to this activity will be charged from the Division INSET Fund while travel expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged to school's MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
