DIVISION POPULATION QUIZ (PopDev) and On-the Spot Skills Exhibition

To: Heads of Public and Private, Secondary and Integrated Schools

1. This office in coordination with the Population Commission Office of the Province of Capiz will conduct the Division Population Quiz (POPDEV) and On-the Spot Skills Exhibition on December 16, 2017. Venue will be announced later. The activity will revolve around the theme “Pagkilala sa Kulturang Filipino Tungo sa Kapayapaan, Pagkakaisa, at Pagbabago”
2. The contest aims to
 - a. provide opportunities for Secondary students to showcase their talents and learning in Arts and Social Studies through an exhibition of their skills and performance;
 - b. convey and disseminate the population and development concepts to the youth so that they can rationally decide to become responsible and productive members of the community; and
 - c. advocate among the school youth the general awareness on population issues and concerns.
3. There will be five contest categories namely: Population Quiz, Poster Making, Essay, Jingle writing and Singing and PopDev Debate. Contestants shall be in their complete uniform on the day of the contest. Guidelines and Criteria are stipulated in the Enclosure.
4. A learner is allowed to participate in one event only.
5. Contestants may come from any grade level.

6. Travel and other expenses incurred by the coaches and contestants during the conduct of the activity are chargeable against school MOOE or other sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. While materials, lunch and snacks of the judges, contest facilitators and working committees will be charged against the Division MOOE also subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
7. Participants are requested to bring their own food and provisions for the contest. No registration fee will be collected.
8. There will be top three (3) winners of each contest , however only the first placers and one coach for every contest category shall automatically be the official entries of Capiz Division in the 2018 POPDEV Regional Population Quiz and "On the Spot " Skills Exhibition.

10. Wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

CONTEST GUIDELINES, RULES AND MECHANICS, CRITERIA

A. Pop Quiz

1. Selection and elimination of participants in the Division level contest.
 - a. The Division committee shall determine the mode and the conduct of the contest at this level.
 - b. The Division first placers will represent Capiz Division in the Regional Level.

2. **Contest Questions**
 - a. The Local contest committee in coordination with the Provincial Pop Com office will prepare the questions in accordance with the general test construction principles.
 - b. The contest questions shall be based on the Pop Ed core messages and key concepts:
 - Family Life and Responsible Parenthood
 - Gender and Development
 - Population and Reproductive Health.
 - Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development
 - c. Contestants will be provided with writing sheets that are numbered and color coded. The monitor will collect the writing sheets after each round.
 - d. English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
 - e. Contestants will be given a total of number of (20) questions, of which six (6) are "easy", seven (7) are "average" and seven (7) are "difficult".
 - f. Points for every correct answer will be given as follows:
 - < one (1) point for each "easy" question.
 - < Two (2) points for each "average" question.
 - < Three points for each "difficult" question.
 - g. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question. For questions that require computation, participants are given a maximum of (30) seconds.
 - h. The quizmaster will only read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time.
 - i. Should a participant wish to change an answer that he/she has written down, this answer should be crossed out with one horizontal line. The new answer must be written clearly above the crossed out answer. A participant is allowed to change his/her answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
 - j. The Division champion shall be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring system.
 - k. All ties shall be broken by a question from the "difficult" category.
 - l. The following procedures shall be observed in case of a protest or injury during the actual quiz proceedings:
 - ✓ Only the official coach of the contestant is allowed to raise a protest on the inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the contest.
 - ✓ The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the chairman of the board of judges who shall recognize the protest or inquiry.
 - ✓ The chairman shall announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.

Board of Judges

The Board of Judges shall be composed of the experts in Population Education issues and concerns. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final.

B. On-the-Spot-Skills-Exhibition

ESSAY Writing

- The contestants will be picking their numbers during registration. The number will be the only identifier that will be written in their essay.
- Essay must be at least 800 but not more than 1000 words in English and legibly written in single space in the provided writing pad. Essay must be original and previously unpublished

Criteria for Assessment

- Presentation and style ----- 40%
- Accuracy ----- 20%
- Fairness ----- 20%
- Methodology----- 20%

- Total 100%

C. POSTER MAKING

- * The contestants will be picking their numbers during registration. They will be given a number tag which will be attached to the poster.
- * Any artwork in the poster must be original in design.
- * The contestants will bring their own materials to be used in the skills exhibition except the the illustration board.
- * Any medium can be used or a combination except oils.

Criteria for Assessment

- Creativity and Presentation ----- 50%
- Originality ----- 30%
- Relevance to the theme ----- 20%

- Total ----- 100%

D. JINGLE WRITING AND SINGING

- The order of the presentation shall be determined through draw lots. This will be done during the registration.
- The jingle must be an original composition highlighting the theme. Lyrics must be in English.
- Performance must be done acapella within three (3) minutes.

Criteria for assessment

- Lyrics ----- 50%
(Relevance to the Theme)
- Musicality ----- 30%
(Execution/over-all Performance)
- Originality ----- 20%

- TOTAL ----- 100%

Alloted time for each Skill Exhibition is 60 Minutes.

E. PopDev Debate

Event Rules and Mechanics

Round – Table Argumentation and Debate

The event is a combination of argumentation and debate that is conducted in a round table discussion. It enables the contestant to use his critical analysis and deep reasoning about the different issues that occur in the society. This also develops the ability of the students to organize his ideals promptly and logically. The event shall follow the following guidelines.

- a. There shall only be one (1) contestant /debater from the participating schools. The debater shall be accompanied and trained by the duly approved coach.
- b. Each contestant shall wear a formal attire. Moreover, they are required to present their valid ID upon registration.
- c. Contestants shall be assigned a number that will correspond to the number on the judging sheet.
- d. Topics to be debated shall revolve on the following issues: country's foreign and economic policies, environment, gender and society, governance, peace and order, population and reproductive health and other current/contemporary issues.
- e. The debater is required to use the English Language as a medium except for terminologies on certain topics that are only stated in Filipino.
- f. The debate will consist of two rounds.

Round One

- g. Each debater will be given a maximum of 3 minutes to deliver his/her speech on a topic given to him/her.
- h. After the discourse of each contestant ,the judge will ask a question. The debater will be given a minimum of two minutes to answer the question.

Round Two

- I. After the first round ,5 debaters will be chosen to proceed to the second round .The debaters will be following the same order as the first round.
- J. A new topic for debate will be given on the second round. The topics will also be selected from the issues enumerated previously for the first round.
- K. Each debater will be given a maximum of 3 minutes to deliver his/her speech on the topic.
- L. After the discourse of the first debater, the second debater will interpelate on the speech of the first debater. The questions for the interpellation will be focused on the arguments of the opponent. Categorical questions will be allowed (answerable by yes or no) however, the responder may choose to qualify or not his/her answer. A total of 5 minutes shall be allotted to other contestants to ask their clarifications ,rebuttal and other questions.
- M. The second contestant will also give his speech on the topic that will be given following the rules number 11 and 12 . The third debater will be asking questions. Debater 3 will be asked by debater 4, debater 4 by debater 5 and debater 5 by debater 1.
- N. Prompting and coaching during the duration of the debate shall be strictly prohibited.

Delivery ——— 25 points

Use of Supporting Evidence ——— 25 points

Organization ——— 25 points

Reasoning and Ability to Answer ——— 25 points

Total ————— 100 points
