**2017 CAPIZ DIVISION BRIGADA ESKWELA CARAVAN AND KICK OFF PROGRAM**

1. Relative to DepEd Memorandum No. 43, s. 2017 (2017 Brigada Eskwela Schools Implementing Guidelines), the Division of Capiz will hold a caravan and kick off program to launch the first day of Brigada Eskwela to be held at Jagnaya National High School, Jagnaya, Jamindan, Capiz on May 15, 2017.
2. The caravan will simultaneously take off from the first and second district of Capiz at around 7:00 in the morning. The route of participants from the 1<sup>st</sup> district will be **Pilar-Pres. Roxas-Brgy. Bailan-Panitan-Loctugan-Lanot-Ivisan-Sigma-Mambusao-Jagnaya (Jamindan)**. For the second district, it will take the route of **Tapaz-Dumalag-Dao-Sigma-Mambusao-Jagnaya NHS (Jamindan)**. Both routes shall have their final stop at Jagnaya National High School, Jagnaya, Jamindan, Capiz at around 9:00 in the morning where the division's kick off program will be held.

Participants are Division Office Personnel, Public Schools District Supervisors/Officers-In Charge of the District, District Brigada Eskwela Coordinators, District PTA Federation Presidents, Secondary & Integrated School Heads, Secondary School Brigada Eskwela Coordinators, Secondary School PTA Presidents and Stakeholders.
4. Expenses relative to the conduct of the weeklong activity shall be charged against the Division Adopt-A-School (ASP) fund, local and other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
