1. This office will conduct the Capiz Division Histoquiz 2018 (Elementary Level) on February 8, 2018 at 8:00 o'clock AM. Venue will be announced later in an advisory.
2. The general objective of this activity is to gauge the content mastery of the pupils in Araling Panlipunan in the Elementary Level and to strengthen the subject by promoting academic excellence in Makabayan and Local History particularly good values, leadership, peace and love of country.
3. Each district is entitled to three (3) contestants for each category, that is, three (3) contestants for Makabayan and three (3) contestants for Local History. Participants are advised to bring packed snacks.
4. The guidelines on the conduct of the contests are found in the enclosure.
5. Travel and other allowable expenses relative to participation to this activity are chargeable against school MOOE while expenses for contest materials, snacks and tokens for the judges shall be charged against the Division MOOE Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Guidelines, rules and Criteria on the conduct of the Division Histoquiz 2018

1. All contestants will answer a set of questions in writing.
2. Questions from all categories will come from the contributed questions from the AP coordinators.
3. Questions must be written in English and must have a Filipino translation.
4. Questions must be read twice by the quizmaster .After the second reading the quizmaster shall say go and the 10 second time limit will begin. After the time limit the buzzer will sound ,the contestants will stop writing and raise their answer sheets.
5. The proctors will read and verify the contests.
6. There are four rounds in the competition namely ; Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher.
7. Points are assigned for each question. **Makabayan** – Easy -1 point, Average – 2 points, Difficult ---- 3 points, Clincher ---- 5 points. **Local History** -- Easy-- 2 points, Average – 3 points, Difficult – 5 points , Clincher --- 5 points.
8. The contestants who get the highest score will be declared the champion .The next highest scorers will be first and second runner-ups.
9. Should there be a tie, the contestant who will get the first 15 points will be declared the winner. Questions will be taken from the clincher questions.
10. The duly registered coach of the contestant is the only authorized person to make a protest.
11. All protests should be referred to the board of judges immediately before the quiz master reads the next question.
12. The Board of judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions and protests.

Rules

1. Each question must be written in a long bond paper cut lengthwise and must contain the name of the reference book, author and page number.
2. Contestants will write their answer in a long bond paper cut lengthwise and must use black or blue pentel pen..
3. Contestants will bring their own pentel pens.
4. Questions will be given by the 18 district coordinators. Each will give 3 questions for every round.
5. Any required information lacking in the submitted questions will not be recognized by the judges.
6. All contests will be administered by the contest administrators.
7. All contests categories will follow the same guidelines, rules and criteria.
