

MECHANICS FOR POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

- 1. In celebration of the National Disaster Resilience Month, this year's theme is "Kahandaan sa Sakuna't Peligro Para sa Tunay na Pagbabago"
- 2. Contest is open to both private and public schools.
- 3. All participants are entitled to One coach or chaperone.
- 4. The Poster Making contest is for Elementary pupils from grades 1-6. Each participant is entitled to one coach only. The top two (2) winners of the Division level shall represent the division in the regional contest on JULY 20, 2019.
- 5. Participants must bring their own 20" x 30" illustration boards which will serve as their canvass as well their own drawing and coloring materials such as crayons, oil pastel, coloring pencils, watercolor, poster paints and markers.
- 6. After the announcement of the central theme of the contest, the participants are given five (5) minutes to consult with the coaches. After that, the participants are given two (2) hours to work on their entries. No more coach or chaperone interference is allowed during the period.
- 7. The artwork shall follow a **PORTRAIT** orientation.
- 8. No text or mark identifying the participant should appear on the artwork.
- 9. After the contest work period, all entries will be submitted to the organizers.
- 10. Judges decision is final and irrevocable.



MECHANICS FOR ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

- 1. In celebration of the National Disaster Consciousness Month, this year's theme is "Kahandaan sa Sakuna't Peligro Para sa Tunay na Pagbabago"
- 2. Contest is open to both private and public schools.
- 3. The Essay Writing Contest is for Secondary and Integrated School students from grades 7-10. Each participant is entitled to one coach only. The top two (2) winners of the Division level shall represent the division in the regional contest.
- 4. Participants must bring their laptops. Internet access of the laptop and mobile phones should be turned off throughout the duration of the contest.
- 5. After the announcement of the central theme of the contest, the participants are given five (5) minutes to consult with the coaches. After that, the participants are given two (2) hours to work on their entries. No more coach or chaperone interference is allowed during the period.
- 6. Works must follow the specifications below:

- 7. Minimum word count is 750 and maximum word count is 2000 in English.
