**DIVISION MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT FOR SY 2019 - 2020**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/ Officer-In-Charge of the Districts  
Heads, Public Elementary, Secondary and Integrated Schools

1. The Division of Capiz will be conducting the Division Mathematics Assessment for School Year 2019 – 2020 on the following schedules.  
First Exposure (Pre-Test) - July 26, 2019  
Second Exposure (Mid-Test) - November 15, 2019  
Third Exposure (Post-Test) - February 14, 2020
2. The assessment aims to:
  - a. gather data on the number of non-numerates in all grade levels from Grade 1 to 10;
  - b. track learners numeracy level; and
  - c. plan for possible interventions to address learners difficulties.
3. The Regional Unified Numeracy Tool (RUNT) will be used in the conduct of the activity. Attached is the guidelines on the administration and interpretation of the test results.
4. Reproduction of the numeracy tool shall be charged against School MOOE for the first exposure, Division HRTD fund for the second exposure and Division MTAP fund for the third exposure subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

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## GUIDELINES ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE REGIONAL UNIFIED NUMERACY TOOL (RUNT)

1. The Regional Unified Numeracy Test (RUNT) will be administered every school year.
2. This will be conducted in three (3) exposures: Pre-Test, Mid-Test and Pos- test.
3. Pre-Test will be conducted on the first to third week of June, Mid-Test on every third and fourth week of September and Post-Test on every first and second week of February.
4. The test will be conducted to all grade levels . This is consists of the four (4) basic fundamental operations. Grade 1 and 2 (Addition and Subtraction only), Grade 3 (Addition, Subtraction and Multiplication) and Grades 4 to 10 (Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division).
5. Grade 1 to 6 learners will take the test for five (5) minutes while Grades 7 to 10 will take the test for three (3) minutes only.
6. Learners who will get at least 80% correct answer of the total number of items will be categorized as numerates.
