**TRAINING - WORKSHOP ON TECHNOLOGY
INTEGRATION IN ALL SUBJECT AREAS**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors
Heads of Public Elementary, Secondary and Integrated Schools

1. The Schools Division of Capiz, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, will conduct the Training-Workshop on Technology Integration in All Subject Areas on August 14-16, 2019 for Batch 1 - Elementary Level and August 28-30, 2019 for Batch 2 – Secondary Level and Integrated Schools. The venue will be announced later.
2. The Training-Workshop on Technology Integration in All Subject Areas aims to:
 - a. acquire basic knowledge on some of the available Technology-Enhanced Learning (TEL) applications and tools;
 - b. develop skills in using selected TEL applications and tools to improve teaching and learning in elementary and secondary schools across all disciplines; and
 - c. collaborately plan, design and implement a lesson plan with activities that uses TEL applications and tools.
3. The participants to this activity are elementary school teachers – eight from each learning area (Filipino, Math, English, Science, Araling Panlipunan, EPP/TLE, MAPEH, & Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao who will be chosen by their respective Education Program Supervisor), and one (1) from each secondary and integrated school. They are requested to bring laptop/tablet, smartphones, Wi-Fi device with internet connectivity, extension cord, CG, sample DLL/DLP and test materials.
4. A registration fee of P1,500.00 shall be charged to each participant from the secondary and integrated school in order to defray the expenses for food and venue of the Training-Workshop.



5. Travel and other allowable expenses of participants are chargeable against local funds while the materials, lunch and snacks of the participants from the Elementary Level and Training Team will be charged against HRTD Funds both subject to compliance with existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
