**THE 2019 MTAP-DepED SATURDAY MATHEMATICS PROGRAMS**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors / OICs of the District  
Heads of Public Elementary, Secondary and Integrated Schools  
Heads of Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepED), Division of Capiz will be offering the 2019 MTAP-DepED Saturday Mathematics Programs for Regular and Talented Learners from Grade 1 to Grade 11.
2. The first program aims to: a.) provide learners with the opportunity to explore mathematics without the threat of tests; b) review the materials covered last school year to enable learners to do well in Mathematics this school year; and c) prepare the Grade 6 pupils and Grade 10 students for the entrance examinations for Grade 7 Junior High School and Grade 11 Senior High School (SHS) respectively. In addition to objectives (a) and (c), the second program aims to prepare talented learners for the Metrobank-MTAP-DepED Math Challenge Competition. Participation to these programs is on **voluntary basis only**.
3. The Saturday Mathematics Program for regular learners in the Division of Capiz will be conducted on six (6) Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon from August 10 to September 14, 2019. The sessions will be for pupils/students who belong from the 25<sup>th</sup> percentile to the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile at each grade/year from Grade 1 to Grade 11. A written permit from parents is necessary.
4. The Saturday Program for Mathematically Talented Learners will be conducted on seven (7) Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon from October 26 to December 14, 2019. The sessions will be for pupils/students who belong to the top 15<sup>th</sup> percentile. The school principal shall endorse pupils who wish to participate upon presentation of the permit from the parent/guardian.



5. There will be a nominal fee of Two Hundred Pesos (PhP200.00) for the six (6) sessions and Two Hundred Fifty (PhP250.00) for the seven (7) sessions, which must be paid at the Center where the student will participate. The Center Coordinator and the Center Principal have to organize a parent circle or mobilize the existing Parents Teachers Association (PTA) to take charge of the collection.
6. Prior to the conduct of the Saturday Mathematics Program for the regular learners, a reorientation for Saturday Mathematics Program trainers and center coordinators for both elementary and secondary levels on August 2, 2019, 8:00 – 11:30 am for the elementary group and 1:00 – 5:00 pm for the secondary group at Capiz National High School Alumni Hall, Roxas City. Each district will send six (6) trainers to represent the six grade levels and the District Math Coordinator while for the secondary level, the School Math Coordinator and one (1) teacher trainer will attend the orientation.
7. Expenses relative to the conduct of the reorientation will be charged against the Division MTAP Fund subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
