## Contest Mechanics

### COMIC-STRIP MAKING CONTEST MECHANICS

(elementary and secondary)

1. The contest is open to all elementary and secondary teachers and learners. Only one entry per school in secondary and one per district for elementary is allowed.
2. Medium of the comic-strip must be written in Filipino. It must be original or no violation to Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).
3. Entry must conform to moral standards. Hence, should adhere to contest theme and promotion of child rights.
4. The strip must have 10-sequence of drawings only with text in balloons and captions arranged in interrelated panels to display and in landscape orientation/format.
5. Characters are animated.
6. Contestants are advised to use pencil, ballpen in black ink and in long size of coupon bond.
7. Entries in scanned copy must be submitted online to Myrthyl Coching for secondary and Gina Artuz for elementary in two copies, black and white and colored.
8. There will be three winners from elementary and secondary level. The first place entry will be used as IEC materials and will be distributed to schools.
9. Violation to any rule is ground for disqualification.
10. Decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
