LAUNCHING OF PROJECT MathALINO (MATH ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING IN NUMERACY ONLINE)

To: Public Schools District Supervisors
Heads of Concerned Elementary, Integrated and Secondary Schools

1. The Schools Division of Capiz, through the Curriculum Implementation Division will launch the banner project of Mathematics as named Project MathALINO (Math Assessment of Learning in Numeracy Online) on May 25, 2021.
2. Project MathALINO is a teacher assisted assessment online. However, for learners who will not be able to join the online assessment, a hard copy of the tool will be provided for the teachers to administer, collect and check. Results of both online and offline assessment will be consolidated and reported to the Division Office.
3. This project aims to:
 - a. Assess the numeracy level of Grades 1 – 10 learners of the division;
 - b. Gather feedback from the teachers on the numeracy status of learners ; and
 - c. Plan for possible intervention that would improve the numeracy level of learners.
4. The eighteen (18) District Mathematics Coordinators and seventy-eight (78) secondary and integrated school coordinators are to attend the virtual launching of the project. Link of the virtual launching will be posted at the Capiz Division Mathematics Group Chat.
5. Prior to the launching of the project, a pilot testing will be conducted on May 24, 2021 at Capiz National High School with grade 8 students as participants of the pilot testing.
6. Mechanics of the Project MathALINO and committee members during the implementation will be discussed and presented during the launching of the project.

7. Expenses relative to the conduct of the project shall be charged against Division INSET Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
