**ONLINE ORIENTATION ON THE CONDUCT OF MONITORING AND EVALUATION (M&E) RE
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MOST ESSENTIAL LEARNING COMPETENCIES (MELCs) OF THE SPECIAL
EDUCATION (SPED) AND SPECIAL CURRICULAR PROGRAMS (SCPs)**

To: **Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS)
Heads of Elementary and Secondary Schools Implementing SPED and SCPs**

1. The Department of Education Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) through the Special Curricular Programs Division (SCPD) shall monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) of the Special Education (SPED) and the Special Curricular Programs (SCPs) namely: Special Program in the Arts (SPA), Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL), Special Program in Journalism (SPJ), Special Program in Sports (SPS), Special Science Program (SSP) and Special Program in Technical Vocational Education (SPTVE).

Relative to the above activity, the Department of Education Schools Division of Capiz, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct an Online Orientation on the Conduct of M&E re Implementation of the SPED and SCP MELCs via Microsoft Teams on October 1, 2021, 8:30 AM to 12 noon. Links will be sent to the concerned school heads.
3. This activity aims to discuss the rationale and processes behind the conduct of Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) on the Implementation of the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) of the Special Education (SPED) and the Special Curricular Programs (SCPs).
4. Participants to this activity are the School Heads of schools implementing SPED and Special Curricular Programs and the teachers handling the special program subjects in SPED and SCPs. Participants are expected to have strong internet connection and preferably with laptop during the orientation.
