 - b. **IPON Conference** is a webinar for DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel and parents to be conducted with top-notch thought leaders in financial literacy. The webinar aims to empower DepEd workers and parents to achieve financial resiliency. The concept of "ipon" or saving up for rainy days, which is one of the pillars of an effective personal financial plan, is the inspiration of this project given the importance of putting aside resources in preparation for unexpected expense and would shift the mindset of being in control of one's financial future.
