The Department of Education (DepEd) Central Office (CO), through its External Partnerships Service (EPS), in partnership with the members of the National Teachers' Month Coordinating Council (NTMCC), annually conducts activities to celebrate the National Teachers' Month (NTM) pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242, s. 2011 titled "Declaring the Period from September 5 to October 5 of Every Year as National Teachers' Month." The culmination of this celebration is through the National Teachers' Day (NTD) / World Teachers' Day (WTD) Celebration on October 5, 2022, pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 10743 titled "An Act Declaring the Fifth Day of October of Every Year as the National Teachers' Day."

This year, the NTD celebration shall be hosted by DepEd Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) to be held at the Abra Sports Complex in Bangued, Abra with the theme: *Gurong Pilipino: Dangal ng Sambayanang Pilipino*. This event shall be primarily participated by DepEd Regions I, II, and CAR together with teacher-participants from all other regions, and representatives from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA).

The Department is counting on your active support and assistance in mounting this event for our teachers. The EXECOM and MANCOM members are all invited to **attend the 2022 NTD** and requested to **send a one-minute video-recorded message** for teachers and for the event **on or before September 30, 2022**. Similar to past celebrations, please be advised of the following requirements and concerns:

1. Allocation of Teachers per Region

All concerned DepEd Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are enjoined to send teacher-participants to the whole day event, preferably those who have not yet joined in past NTD/WTD celebrations.

The table below shows the allocation of participants per region for both public and private teachers:

Travel, food (except for morning snacks, lunch and afternoon snacks during the program), and accommodation (as applicable) expenses of participants shall be charged to local funds. Arrangement for the accommodation shall be made by each participating regions.

All participants including the Teachers Got Talent (TGT) finalists must be fully vaccinated before the date of the actual of event. They must bring

and present their vaccination card or certificate (e-copy or actual card) and a valid ID. Swab test maybe required by the Office of the President especially for the VIPs.

2. Meal Allowance

Funds for the morning snacks, lunch, and afternoon snacks during conduct of the event shall be downloaded to DepEd CAR subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

3. Regional Color Coding

Delegations from DepEd Regions I, II, and CAR shall prepare their respective cheers (5 minutes only) related to the NTD/WTD celebration. Each region will be called to perform in their respective seat assignments. For immediate recognition, regions shall wear color-coded shirt.

4. Teachers Got Talent

Attached as Enclosure 1 are the mechanics of the Teachers Got Talent (TGT) contest and the registration form.

Teachers participating in the TGT shall be included in the total number of participants per region.

5. Registration / Event Tickets/ DepEd or School IDs

As part of the pre-registration process, each RO must email the **complete list of their teacher-participants** in *MS Excel file* to the EPS through ***ntdcelebration@gmail.com*** not later than **September 30, 2022** following the format shown in Enclosure 2.

Subject of the email should be: **“Region _____ List of 2022 NTD Participants.”**

The EPS shall email the e-tickets to the Regional Focal Persons (RFPs) only. The region/ division coordinators shall facilitate the printing of the event tickets and ensure that the registered participants receive their e-tickets. **Each participant should bring their own printed event ticket (or e-copy) which will be presented at the gate of the event venue.** Each event ticket has a

A Teachers' Fair shall be set-up at the event venue. The fair shall feature exhibits, food booths, giveaways, and tokens from our partner stakeholders.

8. Schedule of Activities

The gates of the event venue shall open as early as 6:00 a.m. Booths at the Teachers' Fair shall also be opened around the same time for the participants to visit once they have arrived at the venue.

There will be a morning and an afternoon program. Please see attached program for your reference.

9. Certificates of Appearance and Participation

Each teacher-participant shall be given Certificates of Appearance and Participation. The certificates must be claimed by the RFPs from the registration area after the event. The RFPs shall facilitate the distribution of the certificates to the teacher-participants from their respective regions.

10. Parking Areas

Due to the limited space of the event venue, vehicles must be parked at the designated parking areas outside the event venue. Thus, the participants may only be dropped off at the designated areas near the venue. There will be street signage, traffic enforcers, and/or police officers that will serve as guide as to where the parking areas are located.

There will also be a designated drop-off and parking area for DepEd CO Officials and Regional Directors. Please coordinate with the contact persons below for the issuance of CAR PASS for proper identification.

11. Regional Focal Persons (RFPs)

Each region should assign their respective RFPs whom the organizing team may coordinate with regarding the participants' information and other necessary details. 6. Raffle Draws

TEACHERS GOT TALENT
Contest Guidelines

As part of this year's National Teachers' Day (NTD)/ World Teachers' Day (WTD) Celebration in Bangued, Abra on October 05, 2022, the Department of Education (DepEd), through its External Partnerships Service (EPS), shall hold the Teachers Got Talent (TGT) Competition.

1. The contest is open to public school teachers from DepEd Regions I, II, and CAR only.
2. The contest is open to any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting, etc.
3. The following are strictly prohibited during the performance:
 - Use of flammable materials such as fireworks or pyro techniques
 - Live animal as part of the performance
 - Individual props that exceed 3 feet in height, width and length, except for cloth.
4. A 5-point deduction from the judge's score shall be made per violation incurred. An assigned committee composed of the regional supervisors shall be in-charge of the inspection of the materials, props, etc. prior and after the competition to ensure compliance as mentioned in item number three (3).
5. Only one contestant (or group) per school shall be allowed to join. If joining as a group, a maximum of ten (10) members shall be allowed to comprise said group. Previous champions are no longer qualified to join to give chance to others.
6. Each interested individual or group shall coordinate with their respective regional office (RO) for the application and in order to be included in the official list of delegates.
7. The DepEd RO must have a maximum of five (5) endorsed participants to the CO. If not conducting any region-wide screening; respective regions must determine their five (5) contestants. All participants shall sign the online registration form through this link: <https://bit.ly/3K4pl7z2022TGT>
8. The performance will be pre-recorded and the videographer can utilize different angles using a mobile phone, digital camera, among other means. The presentation should last for a maximum of seven (7) minutes only. Two (2) points will automatically be deducted for excess minute/s.

9. Once the video recording is available, the contestants shall upload the video with a brief caption on the 2022 Teachers Got Talent group page: <https://bit.ly/3wcgWcy2022TGT> and fill the online registration form.
10. **All entries must be submitted not later than September 28, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. All entries received beyond the said time shall no longer be considered.**
11. The seven (7) finalists as determined by the TGT committee will receive a call and email from the committee on the following week for further instructions and guidelines and will go to the finals.
12. General orientation and rehearsal/blocking will be on **October 4, 2022, 5:00 p.m.** at the event venue.
13. During the final performance on October 5, the scores will be tallied at the end of the seven (7) performances, and the announcement of winners will follow shortly.
14. The judges' decisions are final and cannot be subjected to review, debate, contest, or dispute.
15. The criteria for judging are as follows:

Talent and Skill	50%
Originality and Creativity	25%
Projection and Overall Impact	25%
TOTAL	100%

16. Cash prizes will be awarded to the winners, to wit:

Champion	30,000
1 st Runner Up	25,000
2 nd Runner Up	20,000
4 Consolation Prizes	5,000 each
