#### CREATION OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE ON THE PROFESSIONALIZATION AND DEPOLITICIZATION OF APPOINTMENTS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

- Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 9155, also known as the Governance of Basic Education Act, a framework for the governance of basic education was provided as the State recognized schools and learning centers as the most important vehicle for the teaching and learning of national values and for developing in the Filipino learners love of country and pride in its rich heritage.
- Towards this end, the State, through RA 7836, otherwise known as the Philippine Teachers Professionalization Act, shall ensure and promote quality education by proper supervision and regulation of the professionalization of the practice of the teaching profession, among others.
- Corollary, the Board for Professional Teachers Resolution No. 435, series of 1998 known as the Code of Ethics for Professional Teachers, required teachers, in the practice of their noble profession to strictly adhere to, observe, and practice the set of ethical and moral principles, standards, and values.
- In view of this, it is crucial for the Department of Education (DepEd) to put the right people in the right position to address the learning gaps among Filipino students. The Department shall also adopt measures to ensure that teaching and nonteaching personnel continuously adhere to high level of professionalism in the workplace.
- To come up with improved policy on the professionalization and depoliticization in the appointments of teaching, nonteaching personnel and third level officials, the Department shall form an Ad Hoc Committee composed of the following:

- The Ad Hoc Committee shall have the primary responsibility of reviewing the current policies and procedures of appointments of DepEd officials and personnel.
- The Ad Hoc Committee shall likewise formulate guidelines on the professionalization and depoliticization of appointments.
- The Department, through the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development (BHROD), shall oversee the coordination of the Ad Hoc Committee as the Secretariat, under the supervision of the Secretary.
- This Order shall take effect immediately until completion of activities covered by this Order or until sooner amended, repealed, rescinded, or superseded.
