ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 12 (NAT G12) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023

- 1. In consonance with DepEd Memorandum No. 1, s. 2023 titled "Administration of the National Achievement Test for Grade 12 for the School Year 2022-2023", the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) with the assistance of this Office shall administer the National Achievement Test for Grade 12 (NAT G12) on January 30-31, 2023 to all currently enrolled Grade 12 learners in public and private schools through a paper-based modality.
- 2. NAT G12 is an exit assessment designed to determine if graduating learners are meeting the learning standards in the Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum. The test result of the NAT G12 provides data on the percentage of Grade 12 learners attaining at least the minimum level of proficiency in the Key Stage 4 SHS core areas over the total number of Grade 12 learners.
- 3. DepEd has to identify and articulate indicators and targets for measuring performance in the development plans and policies as per DO No. 29, s. 2022 titled "Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework".
- 4. Anent this, the School Management, Monitoring, and Evaluation (SMME) Section of the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) will conduct an Orientation on the Standardized Test Administration to all Secondary School Heads and Secondary School Testing Coordinators (with Senior High School Program) on January 18, 2023, 8:30 AM to be held at the Capiz Division Multipurpose Hall, Banica, Roxas City.
- 5. Expenses of the participants relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against the School MOOE funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
