- 1. On January 11, 2008, the Junior Chamber International Senate, the Department of Education, and the Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement on the conduct of Project W.A.T.C.H (We Advocate Time Consciousness and Honesty), an advocacy movement for punctuality and honesty led by Junior Chamber International Senate.
- 2. In this light, to strengthen the values of punctuality and honesty among DepEd officials and employees, the Department of Education issued DepEd Memorandum No. 160, s. 2008 titled "Project W.A.T.C.H. an Advocacy Movement for Punctuality and Honesty" and DepEd Memorandum No. 387, s. 2008 titled "Activities to be Undertaken to Implement the Project W.A.T.C.H" as an important step in creating a structural change or societal transformation among officials and employees.

To activate Project W.A.T.C.H Clubs and movement for punctuality and honesty within this Division, this Office will implement Project C.A.T.C.H (*Capiz Division Advocates on Time Consciousness and Honesty*) as an initiative to address the "Filipino Time" stigma and to strengthen honesty among students and employees.

VI Objective	Filipinos are well-known for its "Filipino Time", and sadly most of us is really possessing this kind of behavior without considering the negative side of being late. Being late is one of the major problems not just in workplaces but as well in school premises. To counter the stigma of being late, last January 11, 2008, at Ramon Magsaysay High School, Cubao, Quezon City the JCI Senate Philippines, the Department of Education (DepEd), and the Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities (PACUI) have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on the conduct of Project W.A.T.C.H (We Are Time Conscious and Honesty- an Advocacy Movement for Punctuality and Honesty. This is to strengthen the importance of punctuality and honestly among Filipinos. The former President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo then issued last May 21, 2009, Presidential Proclamation No. 1782 titled "Declaring the Month of June as W.A.T.C.H Month" (We Advocate Time Consciousness and Honesty) to develop value formation in building wholesome personality and character among Filipinos, especially the young. As part of sustaining the movement's advocacy. We, at the Schools Division of Capiz will implement Project C.A.T.C.H (Capiz Division Advocates Time Consciousness and Honesty) as part of the adaptation of the Project W.A.T.C.H in Schools Division of Capiz.
VI.Objective	Generally, Project C.A.T.C.H aims to empower and encourage DepEd Employees and Learners to practice being time conscious and being honest in all aspects.

C.A.T.C.H My Relo	June 2023	Relo is a hilgaynon word for WATCH and as part of the positive reinforcement to the Schools Division of Capiz Personnel, each will be given a wristwatch as a simple way of reminding us to be time conscious. The watches are made locally by local watch makers in the Philippines. It is also our way of supporting the "Gawang Pinoy" brands. Specifically, we will be buying the watches from Live Hope Faith Group, to support their advocacy in helping Cancer patients win their fight. The 50% of the net proceeds of this business enterprise will be donated to the cancer patients.
