ON-THE-SPOT READING AND NUMERACY ASSESSMENT

1. Relative to the implementation of the Basic Education Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan (BE-LRCP) and the Reading and Numeracy Roadmap of SDO Capiz to address the gaps and learning losses, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct an on-the-spot reading and numeracy assessment beginning April 2023.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. monitor the results of the conduct of the intervention in schools in key stage 1 for reading and numeracy of priority districts;
 - b. gather feedback;
 - c. provide technical assistance; and
 - d. recognize the effort of teachers and school heads in filling the gaps caused by the pandemic.
3. The assessors shall be composed of the Education Program Supervisors and Public Schools District Supervisors, headed by the Chief Education Supervisor of CID, Dr. Segundina F. Dollete.

4. Education Program Supervisors in charge of MTB/MLE, Filipino, English, and Mathematics will develop the assessment tool to be used during the on-the-spot reading and numeracy assessment.
5. Teachers with one hundred percent (100%) readers in MTB, FILIPINO, and English and one hundred percent (100%) numerates will immediately receive a certificate of merit.
6. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against the Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. It is expected that in the conduct of this activity, all involved must adhere to minimum health and safety protocols set by the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) and the Department of Health (DOH).
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
