3rd REGIONAL ROVER MOOT

 The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Western Visayas Region pursuant to its 2023 Approved Regional Calendar of Scouling Events and Observances is pleased to announce the holding of the 3RD REGIONAL ROVER MOOT on 7-12 JULY 2023 at PROVINCIAL TREE PARK, BRGY. STA. TERESA, JORDAN, GUIMARAS with the theme, "Sustaining Growth".

2. AIMS and OBJECTIVES

Participants of the Rover Moot are expected to:

- Participate and contribute in the development of local communities through immersion activities and service project implementations utilizing camporaft and scoutcraft knowledge and skills.
- b) Promote sharing of ideas, strategies, and dialogues about coping-up the inevitable effects of pandemic and present different holistic resiliency initiatives to the communities to move forward and be productive.
- c) Strengthen camaraderie and fellowship among the Rovers Scouts in the region while learning and enjoying scouting service in the open air.

At the end of the Regional Rover Moot, all participants will automatically be granted One Hundred (100) Points for their advancement to the next higher Quadrant.

3. QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

The following are minimum qualifications for the participating Rover Scouts, Rover Leaders, and Regional Service Team:

a) ROVER SCOUTS

- i. Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle in good standing.
- Must be sixteen (16) to twenty six (26) years old or those who are in Junior or Senior High School registered in the Rover Section.
- Must be physically fit and in good health condition as certified by the licensed physician through a medical certificate.
- iv. Should have a Parent's permit or consent if below eighteen (18) years old.
- v. Should have a complete set of camping gears and equipment.
- vi. Expected to have good leadership potential and camping skills.
- vii. Should be Fully Vaccinated with a Covid-19 vaccine (w/ vaccination Card).

b) ROVER LEADERS

i. Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle.

- Must be physically fit and in good health condition as certified by the licensed physician through a medical certificate.
- iii. Must be of good moral character.
- iv. Should have a complete set of camping gears and equipment.
- Should have undergone Basic Training Course and/or preferably a Bead-Holder or a graduate of the ATC for the Leader of Adults.
- vi. Should be Fully Vaccinated with a Covid-19 vaccine (w/ vaccination Card).

c) REGIONAL SERVICE TEAM

- Must be currently registered in the BSP as Rover or Adult Leader aged eighteen (18) to fifty (50) years old.
- With good moral character and physically fit and healthy as certified by the licensed physician through a medical certificate.
- iii. Must be a Woodbadge Holder and has rendered one (1) year scouting service or experience in the
- Should be Fully Vaccinated with a Covid-19 vaccine (w/ vaccination Card).
- Must be recommended and endorsed by the Council Scout Executive or Officer-in-Charge.

4. QUOTA PER COUNCIL

All Local Councils are required to send a minimum of ONE HUNDRED (100) PARTICIPANTS. A standard ratio of One (1) Rover Leader for every Nine (9) Rover Scouts (1:9) should be observed in the composition of each Contingent. Furthermore, each Local Council is allowed to send a maximum of TEN (10) APPLICANTS FOR THE REGIONAL SERVICE TEAM. Application for the RST should reach the regional office on or before 10 April 2023.

5. REGISTRATION FEE

A registration FEE OF FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P 500) shall be charged from each participant including the RST to defray expenses for program materials, certificates, individual souvenir items, and other related administrative costs during the event.

Remittance and deposit of the registration fees shall be done in bulk ONLY by the authorized Council Staff of the respective Local Council. NO individual deposit shall be allowed to properly account the total registrants per council. Please see bank details below:

NO ON-SITE registration shall be allowed. Registration Fee is not refundable, but is transferrable. Deposit slips together with the roster of participants should be emailed to bsp.wvr@scouts.org.ph and to the host council at bsp.guimaras@scouts.org.ph. Deadline of registration fee is on 07 JUNE 2023.

Participation of the Rover/ Adult Leaders and Members of the RST is further requested to be on OFFICIAL BUSINESS.

6. ROVER EQUIPMENTS AND FOOD PROVISIONS

Standard Rover Circle equipment is prescribed in this Moot. Handy materials and gears (e.g. tent, sleeping gears, etc.) are suggested to be brought by each contingent. Each contingent is required to bring and manage their own food provisions to last for the whole duration of the Moot. Wet and dry Jamboree markets will also be installed within the camp to ensure food supplies in reasonable prices.

7. TRAVEL ITINERARIES

All Contingents are required to submit their travel itineraries on the above mentioned email address for record and reference purposes. Participants are required to be present at the venue at 0800H of July 07 2022 and will only be cleared to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremony.
