- 4. Participation to this activity is voluntary. Each District and Secondary School is requested to send one (1) contestant for each event category. Participants are requested to Pre-register .Link is posted in KATAP and AP ELEM Coordinators GC.
- 5. The guidelines for the conduct of this activity are found in Enclosure No.1 of this memorandum.
- 6. First Place winners of this activity will represent Capiz Division in the Regional Competition.
- 7. Expenses relative to participation to this activity such as travel and food of the participants shall be charged to School MOOE while expenses incurred for the conduct to this activity shall be charged to Division INSET fund shall be charged to Division INSET fund subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations

GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF HISTO QUIZ 2023

- 1. The competition is open to all learners enrolled for the SY 2022-2023.
- LRN of the contestants must be written on the registration form during the contest.
- 3. Questions from all categories will come from the Araling Panlipunan Coordinators in the Secondary Level, while in the Elementary level questions will come from the Araling Panlipunan District Coordinators.
- 4. Questions must be written in Filipino.
- 5. Each question must be written in a long bond paper cut in a half lengthwise, and must contain the name of the reference book, author and page number. Any required information lacking will not be recognized by the board of judges.. Questions must be written in black or blue marker pens.
- 6. Questions from the Araling Panlipunan both Elementary and Secondary must be submitted one week before the contest.
- 7. Contestants will write their answers on a long bond paper cut lengthwise, they will bring their own marker pen (pentel pen) for the contest.
- 8. There are 4 rounds in the competition, EASY, AVERAGE, DIFFICULT and CLINCHER.
- 9. In all levels 6 questions will be asked in the easy round, 7 questions for the average round and 10 questions for the difficult round and no limit for the (clincher)tie breaking questions.
- 10. Points will be assigned to each question.
 - a. Easy 1 point
 - b. Average 2 points

(perfect score - 50 points)

- c. Difficult 3 points
- 11. In the conduct of the test ,the quizmaster will read the question twice, after the second reading the quizmaster shall say GO and the 10 second time limit will

begin, the buzzer will sound after 10 seconds, the contestants will stop writing and raise their answer sheets.

- 12. The proctors will read and verify the answers.
- 13. Should there be a tie ,the contestant who will get the first 15 points will be declared winner.
- 14. The duly registered coach is the only one authorized to make a protest.
- 15. All protests should be referred to the Board of Judges before the next question will be read by the quizmaster.
- 16. The Board of Judges will be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions and protests.
