Special Greetings of PEACE and MABUHAY from the PESPA Executive Offices and board of Directors!

This is in connection to the letter that we have received from your good office regarding our upcoming 40th Principals Training and Development Program Cum National Board Conference to be held in Atrium of Limketai Mall, Cagayan de Oro from July 17 to July 19, 2023.

With respect to your decision to have the participation to our training program be on a voluntary basis, we respectfully appeal to your good office to have such attendance of the participants be on official business instead and have the event officially endorsed by the Department of Education. We recognize that pursuant to the DepEd Memorandum no. 12, s. 2023, a Moratorium is in place for certain Professional Development programs in an effort to implement the DepEd MATATAG Agenda. However, we would like to point out that the DepEd Memo in question contains no provisions that prohibits the conduct of our training program in the same way that it has always been conducted in the past 4 decades.

As such, we maintain our appeal on the grounds that our organization has done its due diligence of informing and submitting to the DepEd Central Office all necessary and pertinent information regarding the conduct of our training program well before the Moratorium was put into effect. Specifically, a letter requesting that the attendance for the program be done on an official business was already submitted on November 25, 2022 whereas the Moratorium was only released and implemented last March 2, 2023. Moreover, we have also submitted a letter regarding the itemized list of possible expenses was submitted to the Human Resources and Organizational Development office on January 20, 2023. This is pursuant to the DBM Circular no. 563, s. 2016 whose provision specifies that government officials and employees may be authorized to participate in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia, and such other activities conducted by non-government organizations or private institutions for a fee, as part of the human resource development program of the government, chargeable against government funds.

This appeal on the attendance for our training program is not without precedent. As this is already the 40th annual training program, all previous training programs of this organization have always been done on official business. As a recognized professional organization, these annual events serve as this organization's exercise of our right to convene and the rights of our members to participate. The nationwide scale of our conventions not only serves as the perfect platform to train school heads and leaders across the country, it also serves as a platform initiate discourse on relevant issues and concerns and to build rapport between school heads. Not only is this beneficial for our organization but it also benefits the Department of Education as a whole as these activities have the ultimate goal of equipping the members and participants in their duties as school heads. We stress our point that four decades of this organization's operation have always been conducted in line with the trust and mandate of the Department of Education. As such, attendance on official business guarantees us the opportunity to continue doing so.

Therefore, it is hoped that this request will be given favorable action from your office.
