#### DIVISION LITERACY AND NUMERACY TRAINING

- 1. In line with the National Reading and Mathematics Program and the Division Basic Education Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan (BE-LRCP), this office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct a Division Literacy and Numeracy Training. This will be conducted in four batches on November 24-26,2023 (First Batch: Kindergarten and ALS teachers), December 1-3, 2023 (Second Batch: Grade 1 teachers), December 8-10,2023 (Third Batch: Grade 2 teachers), and December 15-17,2023 (Fourth Batch: Grade 3 teachers). The venue will be announced later.
- 2. Specifically, this activity aims to:
  - a. implement DepEd 3B's (Bawat Bata Bumabasa) Program;
  - b. enhance teachers' knowledge and skills in teaching reading and numeracy; and
  - c. improve the reading and numeracy performance of learners who are lagging behind.
- 3. The list of the division management team and consultants, resource persons, facilitators, and monitoring team, and the training matrix are found in Enclosure Numbers 1 and 2 respectively.
- 4. In the identification of the participants to this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, civil status, religion or belief, ethnicity, political affiliation, employment status, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression,, and other personal.
