Program Overview

RISE: A Lifetime Scholarship and Leadership Development Opportunity

Rise is a program that finds and supports brilliant people who need opportunity for life as they work to serve others. They believe that brilliance is equally distributed but seems not for others. They are on a mission to change the odds for the most brilliant people from all over the world at an early age and support them for life.

What is RISE?

PHILOSOPHY: We recognize that opportunities are equally distributed, but opportunities seem not. RISE is on a mission to address this problem.

PURPOSE: RISE is a program that looks for brilliant people who need opportunities thus support them for life as they work to serve others.

WHAT MAKES RISE DIFFERENT?

- 1. It is a global community.
 - 100k+ Registered from 170 countries
 - Finalists from 99 countries
 - Global winners from 47 countries
- 2. It is a program for life.
 - Lifetime personal and professional development

CANDIDATE JOURNEY

Who can join?

- Must be between the ages of 15 and 17 as of July 1, 2024
- With 5 Rise Traits: Brilliance, Perseverance, Integrity, Empathy, and Calling

Since the only eligibility requirement is age, everyone who applies will be able to:

- 1. Join a global community and can participate in the Rise Discord
- 2. Gain access to free online resources and events
- 3. Experience project based learning and human centered design approaches for social impact
- 4. Receive opportunities from our partners around the world.

The first round of elimination selects **500 finalists** who will be given the opportunity to:

- 1. Participate in bespoke educational and leadership courses as an award from Rise
- 2. Gain access to additional funding opportunities to experiment with innovative ideas to solve difficult challenges
- 3. Receive other benefits such as Duolingo English Test Waivers.

From the remaining 500 finalists, only **100 Global Winners** will receive the following:

- 1. Benefits for life to scale their impact, tailored to their needs as they evolve over time
- 2. Needs-based college scholarship this may also include graduate scholarships and funding to start a social enterprise
- 3. Invitation to a fully funded Residential Summit

- E. Quizzes and Games. Showcase a different side of your brilliance with the Puzzle Quiz.

How to complete a Rise Project?

1. Focus and Research

- Explain your project focus and how it links to your passions
- Describe your research
- Outline your research's impact on your focus area and plans

2. Design and Plan

- Share the goals of your project
- Explain your project design and why it meets your project goals
- Refer to the detailed plan you have created to achieve your outcomes
- Tell us about any ethical considerations you accounted for

3. Act and Reflect

- Outline what you did for your project with accompanying evidence
- Compare your plans and how your project ran in practice
- Reflect on the full project journey, with key learnings and anything that you would do differently if you started again
