- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct an assessment dubbed as **Ensuring Equity and Inclusion: Assessing the Special Education Needs of Learners** on November 6-8, 2023. The venue will be at Pontevedra Elementary School on November 6, 2023, while on November 7-8, 2023 the venue will be at the Division Multi-purpose Hall, Banica, Roxas City.
- 2. This assessment aims to:
 - a. develop an understanding of the unique needs and abilities of learners with special needs, including their cognitive, physical, and social-emotional development; and
 - b. provide teachers with important information to guide them in assessing the progress and understanding of learners with special needs, such as using alternative assessment methods and accommodations, modifying instruction and assessment to meet their individual needs, and involving families and caregivers in the process.
- 3. The list of schools, schedule, venue, and number of learners to be assessed can be found in Enclosure Number 1.
- 4. In the identification of the participants to this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, civil status, religion or belief, ethnicity, political affiliation, employment status, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, and other personal. It is expected









that in the conduct of this activity, all involved must adhere to minimum health and safety protocols.

- 5. All concerned are advised to ensure compliance with DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017, (Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities).
- 6. Assessment fee will be charged to the **SPED Support Fund (RO-6-23-0561)** downloaded to the school, while food and travel expenses of the learners and teachers shall be charged to school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
