requirement for all research categories shall be prepared by the participants in preparation for the Science Congress activity. Participants may print and bring a copy of their manuscripts for easy reference during the competition.

6. The Division Science/Mathematics Education Program Supervisors or designated SciMathlympics focal persons shall submit a Google Drive link containing their official entries manuscripts, scanned research logbook, needed ISEF Forms, endorsement letter, and Division SciMathlympics Report to the messenger/email of Dr. Rovel R. Salcedo on or before November 15, 2023. The file name should follow the following syntax:

> SDO_Category_Individual or Team Example: Iloilo City_Life Science_Individual

- 7. The Division Science/Mathematics Education Supervisors shall be responsible for the orientation of their participants and the preparation of needed documents such as parents' permits, authority to travel, medical certificates, and the welfare of their delegation.
- 8. This activity will be conducted in a Face-to-Face Modality, thus strict adherence to the Department of Health and Department of Education Joint Memorandum (JMC) No. 1, s. 2021 titled Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of Face-to-Face Learning Modality and DepEd Order No. 17, s. 2022 titled Guidelines on the Progressive Expansion of Face-to-Face Classes, will be observed.
- 9. There will be three winners for each contest event and will be awarded as First, Second, and Third Placers. The winners will receive medals and certificates of recognition. Moreover, the results of the schools divisions' participation will be counted by the Tabulation Committee and the following point system per category will be observed and added to determine the Overall Ranking:

First Place- 5 Points Second Place- 4 Points Third Place- 3 Points Fourth Place-2 Points Fifth Place- 1 Point

The schools divisions will be ranked accordingly, and the Top 5 will receive the following awards and will be awarded the SciMathlympics Banner:

- 6. Adherent to the Department of Health and Department of Education Joint Memorandum (JMC) No. 1, s. 2021 titled Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of Face-to-Face Learning Modality and DepEd Order No. 17, s. 2022 titled Guidelines on the Progressive Expansion of Face-to-Face Classes, this activity will be conducted face-to-face ensuring strict compliance and in accordance with the said issuances.
