SUBJECT : CONDUCT OF SIMULTANEOUS REGIONWIDE EARTHQUAKE
DRILLS AND TSUNAMI DRILLS AS APPLICABLE

Pursuant to the guidance of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Chairperson and Secretary of National Defense, during the National Inter-Agency Coordinating Cell (NIACC) Meeting on 12 October 2025, prioritizing proactive national earthquake preparedness following the recent high-magnitude incidents in Zambales, Davao and Cebu, a simultaneous regionwide earthquake drills and tsunami drills will be conducted in two (2) batches:

Provinces/HUCs	Date and Time
Antique, Iloilo City and Province of Iloilo	October 23, 2025 at 3:00PM
Aklan, Capiz, Guimaras	October 24, 2025 at 3:00PM
Unified Scenario: A powerful magnitude 7.2 earthquake struck Region VI, triggering a tsunami. 3:00 PM – Earthquake (Duck, Cover and Hold) 3:01 PM – Evacuation	

These drills aim to enhance community awareness, readiness, and coordination in responding to seismic and tsunami hazards, ensuring that all offices, personnel, and communities are equipped with the knowledge and skills necessary during such emergencies. This is above and beyond the Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills (NSED) that we conduct quarterly.


All provincial, city, municipal DRRM councils, barangays, national government agencies, schools, state universities and colleges, non-government organizations, civil society organizations, people organizations, private sectors and other partner stakeholders are directed to:

1. Conduct earthquake drills and, where applicable, tsunami drills within their respective jurisdictions or offices;
2. Coordinate with the Regional/Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils for technical guidance; and
3. Submit a concise After-Activity Report (AAR) in Google form, containing the following: public facility name, date the drill was conducted, number of drill participants, the key gaps identified, and the developed improvement plans to ocdrc6@gmail.com **not later than December 2, 2025.**

Your active participation in this regionwide exercise is vital in building a safer and more resilient Region VI.
