In accordance with **Republic Act No. 9155** (Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001), which mandates the Department of Education (DepEd) to promote the participation of non-government organizations (NGOs), local government units (LGUs), and other stakeholders in providing resources for education, and **Republic Act No. 8525** (Adopt-a-School Act of 1998), which encourages private sector participation in delivering quality education by assisting public schools in the Philippines, this Office requests all elementary, secondary, and integrated schools to conduct a school needs/resource gap assessment using the Resource Gap Analysis Tool. The results of the analysis will serve as a reference for identifying potential partners and stakeholders for DepEd programs, projects, and activities.

**Definitions:**

- Resources – quantitative components items needed for the implementation of programs/projects/activities.
- Current state – current visible/observable and quantitative characteristics/situation of the resource.
- Desired state - future visible/observable and quantitative characteristics/situation of the resource.
- Needed – total quantity of resource needed for the implementation of programs/projects/activities.
- Existing – total amount/quantity of resources that are present and shown in your inventory.
- Budgeted – total amount of resources allocated to any given appropriation i.e. School MOOE, Special Education Fund (SEF), General Appropriations Act, General Fund, Donations etc...
- Resource gap – total insufficient/inadequate of resources need which is the difference between the resources needed and the sum of the existing and budgeted resources [Resource Gap = Needed – (Existing + Budgeted)]
- Factors Responsible for the Gaps – comments regarding the potential causes of the resources gap.
- Possible Ways to Address Resource Gaps – strategies or sources of the identified resource gaps.
