This refers to the Joint Memorandum dated April 21, 2026, issued by the Office of the Secretary and the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, titled "*Guidelines on the Utilization of Directly Released Funds for the Provision and Distribution of Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program Teaching and Learning Resources.*"

In view of the foregoing, this memorandum reiterates DM-OULS-2025-051 on the prescribed technical specifications to ensure uniform compliance. These specifications shall continue to be adopted and strictly observed in the implementation of the ARAL Program for School Year 2026-2027. These learning resources and technical specifications may be accessed through: <https://tinyurl.com/DepEdARALLR>.

Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices shall ensure the timely provision and distribution of the prescribed resources based on the number of learners and tutors in each school. They shall likewise exercise sound discretion in determining the learning resources to be reproduced, ensuring alignment with program requirements and responsiveness to the needs of intended beneficiaries.

For guidance on the implementation of the ARAL Program for School Year 2026-2027, the schedule of utilization of the prescribed teaching and learning resources shall be as follows:
