1. The National Association of Public Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NAPSSPHIL) Inc. announces the holding of its **8th Principals Congress** with the theme, The Principal's role in upholding the learner's right to access Basic Quality Education, promoting safety, health and well-being in the New Normal, at the Boracay Paradise Garden Resort and Convention Center, Mangayad, Manoc-Manoc, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan by cluster on the dates stated below.

5. A **registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000)** shall be charged to each participant to cover venue rental, meals, honoraria of speakers, and other related expenses chargeable to local funds and or Special Education Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Official registration of participants will be on Day 0, a day before the congress, to facilitate early registration and they are reminded to be responsible for their hotel accommodation.
